Activities and Objectives

The aim of the Charity is to provide a venue for social activities and clubs in Gravesend. This is to continue next year.

Achievements and Performance

We have had a successful year with a number of societies using the hall on a regular basis. This included a Tea Dance, dance classes for children and adults, a nursery, a stamp club and a Church. Bookings for one-off parties have not been accepted this year due to difficulties with noise levels and mis-use of the hall by some hires in previous years.

Income has increased due to more weekday use of the hall and a levelling-up of the Hall Hire. We have also benefited from a very generous donation which has allowed us to complete a refurbishment of the toilets.

Financial Review

Regular income has exceeded administrative expenditure this year. There are no financial concerns.
