The Trustees present their annual report and the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2022.

GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

Airmyn Memorial Hall is a registered charity No: 10002608 and was established under its Governing Trust Deed dated 29 November 1990. Any interested party may apply to become a trustee. Appointments are confirmed at meetings of the charity.

OBJECTIVES & ACTIVITIES

The object of the charity is the provision and maintenance of Airmyn Memorial Hall and playing field, to include the provision of social, educational, and recreational activities to the residents of Airmyn and the surrounding area.

In the planning of our activities for the year, we kept in mind the Charity Commission's guidelines on public benefit at our trustee meetings. We welcome all residents to use the facilities of the Hall and playing fields.

The focus of our activities remains the hire of rooms to local groups and residents together with fund raising events initiated by committee members. The income from these activities enables us to meet the cost of repairs and maintenance of the Hall. The field is also available for hire and the committee is actively seeking a team to make it their home ground.

ACHIEVEMENTS & PERFORMANCE

During the year, the Hall and field were used by individuals for functions i.e., charity events, christenings, and children's parties. The Hall is used as an outreach Post Office. Line, sequence, and jive dancing continue to be popular with the public. Older residents attend Bingo and an Activity Morning. Sports include football, badminton, and archery. Flower arranging and music groups are also popular. The Parish Council, Neighbourhood Watch and Emergency Team also use the Hall for meetings.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves and Risk Assessment

The reserves policy reflects the wish to maintain financial stability so that we can continue to meet the costs of repairs and maintenance. The policy is regularly reviewed.

The Trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those relating to the operation of the finances of the Charity, and they are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to major risks.

Review of the Year

The accounts show an overall 2023 deficit of £465, however Charity reserves (all of which are unrestricted) amount to £43,855 (compared with £44,320 the previous year)

The Trustee's present their annual report and the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2022.

GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Airmyn Memorial Hall is a registered charity, No. 10002608, and was established under its Governing Trust Deed dated 29 November 1990.

Any interested party may apply to become a trustee. Appointments are confirmed at meetings of the charity.

OBJECTIVES & ACTIVITIES

The object of the charity is the provision and maintenance of Airmyn Memorial Hall and playing field and the provision of social, educational and recreational activities to the residents of Airmyn and the surrounding area.

In planning our activities for the year we kept in mind the Charity Commission's guidelines on public benefit at our trustee meetings. We welcome all residents to use the facilities of the Hall and playing fields.

The focus of our activities remains the hire of rooms to local groups and residents together with fund raising events initiated by Committee members. The income from these activities enables us to meet the costs of repairs and maintenance of the Hall, the field is also available for hire and the committee is actively seeking a team to make it their home ground.

ACHIEVEMENTS & PERFORMANCE

During the year the Hall and field were used by individuals for functions i.e. charity events, christenings, and children's parties. The Hall is used as an outreach post office. Line, sequence and jive dancing continue to be very popular with the public. Older residents attend Bingo and an Activity morning. Sports include football, badminton and archery. Flower arranging and music groups are also popular. The hall is also used for meetings of the Parish Council, Neighbourhood Watch and Emergency Team.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves and Risk assessment

The reserves policy reflects the wish to maintain financial stability so that we can continue to meet the costs of repairs and maintenance. The policy is under regular review.

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those relating to the operations and finances of the charity, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks.

Review of the Year

The accounts show an surplus of income over expenditure of £2,241.

Charity reserves on 31 March 2022 amounted to £44,320 all of which are unrestricted funds.

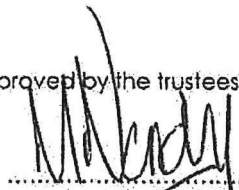

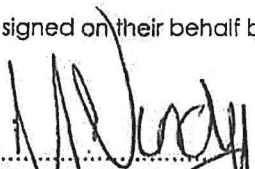

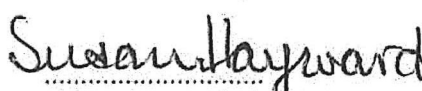
