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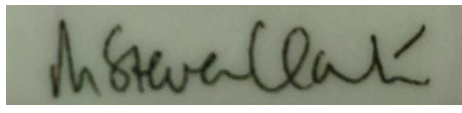

I have completed my examination. I confirm that no material matters have come to my attention in connection with the examination giving me

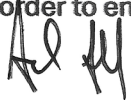
