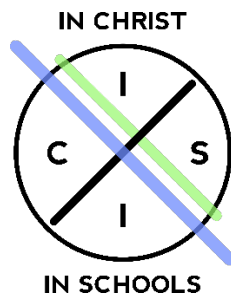

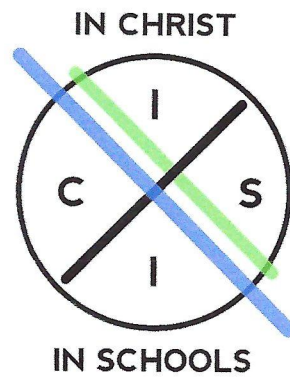

Summary 2021/2022

2021/2022 has seen a continuation of the work of In Christ in schools with some new ventures in secondary schools which fits our mission. We have a smaller team this year and as such some projects, such as our alternative provision planning, have not been able to be staffed. Never the less we are still experiencing demand in primary and secondary schools and Kevin and Cristo

ICIS has developed a new secondary club at a local school run by Kevin and supported by local church volunteer. The club has run consistently and taken students through alpha course videos, had bible teaching and games and prayer. We also helped support a Bible Comes to life exhibition in a local school and Kevin and Cristo supported CMJ in their character re-enactment in churches as part of this exhibition.

ICIS has also worked with the local street pastors to set up a school pastors Mansfield group. Cristo as the director of ICIS is working with the chair of the street pastors and we have 2 volunteers and 2 in the pipeline. This project involves training and coordinating of volunteers from churches to work with schools which sits well with our vision and mission. We are hopeful this will lead to an increase of volunteers to support the schools and collaborate with ICIS.

Kevin and Cristo delivered high quality engaging assemblies to year 5 and 6 students around transition to four primary schools (summer 2021). The assemblies helped with the challenges of moving schools in a post pandemic context. We currently have students accessing our clubs in secondary who were supported in primary schools. Two such students have also served at Lighthouse holiday club. We feel this has been of significant benefit to their life experiences, well-being and spiritual growth.

Kevin continues to deliver bible explorer in 2/3 schools per term. The demand for this is high and feedback is consistently positive. Kevin also leads assemblies to support the SMSC and RE initiatives of schools.

Kevin is part of the chaplaincy team at a local CofE academy and has supported collective worship and Christmas and Easter and Remembrance Day celebrations both in person and via videos. Kevin also served at the summer holiday club Lighthouse.

During lockdowns Kevin and Jenny developed video resources which were made available to students via the school website.

We have continued our vision of working with local churches to connect schools. We have supported and facilitated lunch time clubs with local Church of England and Methodist workers. ICIS will also support a new after-school club in a Church near a local secondary school as well as periodically supporting with a new lunchtime club in the same secondary school.

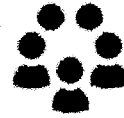

Our Reach is Growing



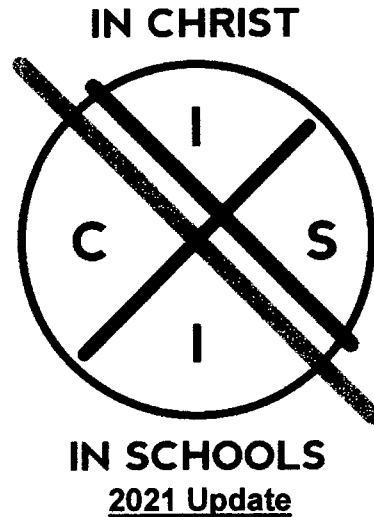
Despite a downturn in the economy God is furthering our ministry opportunities.

God has given us the vision to set up an Alternative Provision (AP) in Mansfield. This is a pioneer ministry supporting the education and life experience of children who need the most help in society. For the first time students would come to our AP centre and develop their mental, physical and spiritual health.



God is also leading us to be at the forefront of School Pastors. This is a brand new venture in Mansfield. Licensed by the Ascension Trust trained volunteers offer coordinated pastoral and spiritual support to secondary schools.

We continue to reach average 3,000 students per term through our assemblies, Bible explorer lessons, lunch and after school clubs in 13 schools in the surrounding area. We creatively communicate the christian message and share the good news of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Part of our mission is that we are helping to connect with Churches and bring their youth workers, leaders and members into our schools for clubs, lessons and events. God is expanding our reach and we are now working closely with secondary schools.

The Director is now the coordinator of Mansfield School Pastors and the work as Chaplaincy at Queen Elizabeth's Academy has grown over the past two years and he recently started a biblical languages clubs where students learn beginners Greek and Hebrew, and will learn Genesis 1:1 and John 1:1 off by heart and in the original languages. He also has a role with a multi academy trust helping to deliver a high quality RE curriculum. There are many opportunities in RE at the moment and God has opened doors to connect with academic forums, charities and delivered a presentation at the University of Nottingham on high quality RE.

Staff are running 'About Life and Faith' Club at Queen Elizabeth's Academy and continues to support with assemblies. All these activities blend pastoral care, biblical teaching and Gospel presentation as well as adding value to the school's offer to students.


With all these open doors we do have a financial need which if left unattended will prevent us from continuing through the open doors. We have reduced our capacity to enable us to continue but at a reduced rate. We are looking for more churches to get behind our mission and for individual donors to partner in our mission.

Plans for 2022

We have approached secondary schools to offer bespoke mentoring and are planning to start an Alternative Provision which is a paid for service to support anxious year 7 students.
