Our finances were hit during this period but North Lincolnshire Council came up with much welcomed support,in the form of grants.

We are always trying to keep our facilities up to scratch & improvingthem where possible,we are looking at the following projects ,for the foreseeable future

Installing Smart Meter Radiator valves to required radiators to enable us turn them on and off individually as required.

This will require a WiFi hub connected to the router.

Creating a path from the car park, to the exit of the main building & on to changing rooms. (This is to improve the exit route, especially for wheelchairs, from the building which at present is onto grass.) & also to provide a better access around building to changing rooms.

The possibilities of replacing the windows in the Beryl Ash meeting rooms & the kitchen (Possibly with PVC)

Finally I could not end my report without mentioning our own scrap merchants Andrew & Jeff Ash whose continuing collection of scrap / taking to the scrap yards, continues to bring in revenue for the hall.

Although we were unable to hold any meetings, in 2020. Bills still had to be paid, and the hall & grounds still had to be maintained .

This was achieved by the efforts, of many seated around this table.

My thanks go out to each and everyone of you for all the hard work you put in,

In what ever shape or form.

We were not able to run a race night ,but we were able to run the ever popular Village Draw.(which is a major fundraiser for the hall.)

Despite losing a few members.We still managed to attract 318 members. Thanks largely to John for coordinating this and a lot of leg work by every committee member.

The winning numbers are normally drawn out,each month at the 3Horse Shoes,

But this was not possible ,so we enlisted the help of the Albion Hill Bakery Delivery Team to draw the winning numbers out.

Meeting/Functions in the hall were brought to a resounding halt,Resulting in loss of revenue .

We were indebted to North Lincolnshire ,for the grants they gave us.

2020 was a year ,when we we're regularly changing tiers, and in order for various organisations to keep going (Taewando/Locomotion Dance Group/ School).We had to produce our own Covid19 risk assessment in order for the groups to meet safely under government guidelines.(Providing they also could produce their own Risk Assessment.) We thank Paul for that.

After every session,before the next could take place,our cleaning operative(Susan) had to go in ,and Covid clean where necessary.

We are indebted to Her for doing this.

When the football season finally started our regular teams Zeera & Black Beauty ,who play in the Scunthorpe & District Sunday League Division 2
Hired our facilities at a reduced rate,because Changing Rooms & Showers could not be used.

A complete Block hit everything ,just before Christmas 2020 meaning the hall

Was closed completely ,Meaning more Loss of revenue.(Again North Lincs Council Stept in with further grants .

The grants that we got, helped us to carry out thefollowing maintaince Vital work on the sewage system.

Changing Rooms Decorated.

The Beryl Ash Meeting room was completely redecorated.

The Emergency Exit Door in the main Hall ,had its crash bar opening system,changed to enable the door to be opened&closed easier.

Suggestions for further improvements, to be considered at future meetings.

Gates Both ends of area ,between New Build &Changing Rooms.

Floor in Main Hall to completely Deep Cleaned.

I would just like to say also that during the closure,in order to comply with our insurance.I have been carrying out a weekly inspection programme,,backing this up with documentation evidence.Similar to the cleaning sheet our cleaning/operative fills in.

We were given the all clear for our regular users(Taewando/locomotion Dance Group to come back &use the hall ,in April 2021 &Football resumed to finish off the season as well as a friendly team,playing on a Thursday night.

It was the latter,who took it on themselves to gain access ,to one of Christopher's residents gardens,which backs onto the playingfield.

This was totally out of order.(strongly worded letter was sent to all our teams,


Reminding them of the correct way to retrieve footballs.)

Unfortunately also towards the end of the season we were also experiencing a problem,with Footballs going over into gardens.(on a A extrodinary meeting was called to sort the matter out to everyone's agreement.)

Unfortunately two of our committee members Pat/RogerWood have tendered their resignations from the committee,for the time bieng.

We thank them for their time & efforts on behalf of the Village Hall.

brings in funds for the hall.
