### **REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES** **for the year ended 30 JUNE 2023**

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

##### **Objectives and aims**

The purpose of Thatcham Rotary Club Trust Fund is to provide financial and practical support to local and national organisations and groups of people in need. Financial support to people affected by disasters and to other charities concerned with the welfare of people in need both locally, at home and in other countries. To provide relief of persons in conditions of need, hardship or distress, and to or for such other charitable purposes, institutions, societies, causes or objects as the club shall in duly constituted meeting from time to time direct.

##### **Significant activities**

To this end the club organises a number of fund raising events throughout the year and distributes the funds raised to other charities and organisations who are best able to provide the practical support to the people in need. This year the club organised a duck race, Santa fun run, concert, a restaurant night and a car show, raising £11,768 after expenses which was distributed as per the schedule of donations at the end of this report.

This year the club was heavily involved in supporting the District 1090 Ukraine Generator Fund, an initiative of the Rotary District 1090 council which involved several of the clubs in the district and many Rotary clubs throughout the UK. The club also acted as banker for the fund.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

##### **Financial position**

The club ended the year with net assets of £9,264 having made charitable donations totalling £12,560. It is club policy to maintain sufficient funds in the club account to cover the expenses of upcoming fundraising events and a bit more for any unexpected requests we might receive and to distribute the rest of the funds raised within a year. The club does not hold a long term invested reserve.

#### **STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT**

##### **Governing document**

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

##### **Recruitment and appointment of new trustees**

The trustees are appointed annually and are the "Officers of the Club" being the President, vice president, secretary and treasurer of the club. This is laid down in the Trust Deed dated 3rd November 1993. The officers of the club are nominated and elected annually at the club AGM held within the six months preceding their term of office.

### **NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS** **for the year ended 30 JUNE 2023**

#### **1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

##### **Basis of preparing the financial statements**

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

##### **Income**

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

##### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

##### **Stocks**

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

##### **Taxation**

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

##### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
