We continue to have a high profile in the local area with many people also following us on social media.

Our cancer patients seem to fluctuate between 25 -30 at any given time and our main support is by way of cash donations to assist with transport to hospital appointments and other expenses. We have many referrals from palliative nurses and other cancer charities when they have no funds available.

We are still a small group of 6 volunteers aiming to support a geographic radius of approximately 10 miles. However, it is impossible to ignore any request for help and we have not yet turned anyone down, and very often we are able to visit the patient the same day.

Many people from all walks of life and businesses support our charity with various donations, in memoriam, and all sorts of fund-raising events and sponsorships and we are overwhelmed by their continued generosity. We are currently in the fortunate position of having very healthy funds, although we still have an amount set aside from the previous fundraiser set up to pay for injections for a young woman who didn't survive. It has always been our intention to utilise those funds if a similar situation arises
