We are a parent/committee run preschool with well qualified staff. This consists of a manager, deputy, Sendco, behaviour management practitioner and practitioners. We have close links with the Pre -school Learning Alliance and the Foundation Stage Cluster Groups.

We annually adopt the Constitution from The Preschool Alliance as our governing document. We have a full range of governing policies, all of which are adopted annually by as committee and always accessible to all parents.

Within our preschool we select a Chairperson, Treasurer and Secretary; we ask for members to come forward, and they are nominated and seconded by other members of the committee, who are all volunteers/ parents/ex parents or members of the local community.

During this year we have run **190** sessions and by January we will be taking 28 children per day. We still provide the wraparound service offering childcare from 08.30 – 3.30pm. We also take children who are eligible for 2-year funding, and the 3 and 4 year funding.

We also have children who receive the extended hours funding. We have currently 7 children on the 30-hour funding with a few more parents who have expressed interest in the longer hours. The preschool is based in a considered area of deprivation and with that in mind we try to keep the fees at an affordable rate for all families. We pride ourselves that we offer good quality affordable childcare in a home from home environment.

We continually strive to have open and transparent relationships with all our parents and ensure we give out accurate and informative information. This could be about funding, or to even offer listening ears to parents when they need additional support.

Despite our current cohort of families not expressing the need for us further extending our hours we regularly check in with our families to check what their needs are and to continually review our daily practice. However, we are continuing to offer the 30-hour funding as we want to offer the service to our parents. Especially in the current economic cost of living crisis.

The 30-hour funding is still not being taken up to its full potential however we are hoping this will improve in time as some parents/carers are still confused as to what this is. As usual this will be monitored and reviewed by the management team and committee and hours dropped or added as necessary.

Although many staff have stayed the same, we are currently about to advertise for a qualified new member of staff to join the team. Through continued and consistent professional development courses, all staff are encouraged to add to their personal achievements, and this shows in their care and love for the job. Our level 3 apprentice is successfully coming to the end of her course and will soon be fully qualified. We are very proud of her and continue to promote staff's interests in courses to build on their interests and experiences.

We still pride ourselves on offering a small home from home committee run preschool to all children aged from 2 years. Our staff have changed however our ethos is still the same. To offer good quality childcare at affordable prices for all families.

Our staffing consists of a manager, deputy, Sendco/behaviour management practitioner and practitioners. We have close links with the Preschool Learning Alliance and the Foundation Stage Cluster Groups in our local areas.

Our staff member are all qualified to a minimum of level 3 with two staff having Fda degrees and B a hons degrees. We have a level 3 apprentice who started off as a parent. All staff are encouraged but never forced to continue to update their skills and training on a regular basis mostly through virtual and online courses.

Since Covid and even the year after we have seen a decline in all areas of early years development especially speech and language development so staff are updating their knowledge to accommodate this. Working closely with parents and families to enable all the children to achieve their full potential.

We annually adopt the Constitution from The Preschool Alliance as our governing document. We have a full range of governing policies, all of which are adopted annually by as committee and always accessible to all parents either in paper form or by accessing them online at any convenient time. These are updated when required.

Our families receive the standard 15-hour funding or apply for the 30-hour funding if eligible which is available to working parents. Some of our families are still from the local area and are in receipt of 2-year funding based on income.

During this year we have run **190** sessions. We still offer the morning session, a full day or morning with a lunch club to enable parental choice. We offer the wraparound service offering childcare from 08.30 – 2.30pm. The preschool is based in a considered area of deprivation and with that in mind we try to keep the fees at an affordable rate for all families. However, due to the cost of living we have upped the charge per hour for both 2- and 3-year-olds. For us being able to offer good quality affordable childcare in a home from home environment is what matters.

Some of our parents work and this year we have seen a few families attend our setting that live on the other side of the town. When we have them, some parents take up the extra sessions as their own cost. Again, this is dependent on who is off on that day through illness or holidays etc. Since Covid we are aware of the financial struggles' families are facing and the higher prices of food. However, we still supply snack for the children as we know how important this is especially for families that are really struggling with their finances.

We have a few families that we have helped with food packages due to the struggling financial climate as well as continuing to signpost to local services when parents need extra support for housing, mental health and similar. We try to offer a listening ear and to signpost parents to where they can get more help.

Again as in previous years we are a small setting and feel we are a depended and necessary service provider to all of our families in the local deprived area. Most staff live in the local community and together we genuinely care about the families and neighbourhood.

We are a small home from home committee run preschool that has been established for over 40 years. Our committee members consist of ex staff members and parents.

We have had a change in staff over the last year but still offer a warm and friendly atmosphere to all families. Our staffing consists of a manager, deputy, Senco/behaviour management practitioner and practitioners. We have close links with the Preschool Learning Alliance and the Foundation Stage Cluster Groups in our local areas.

Our staff members are all qualified and continue to update their skills and training on a regular basis mostly through virtual and online courses. Since Covid we have seen a decline in all areas of our Early years foundation stage curriculum especially speech and language development so staff are updating their knowledge to accommodate this. Working closely with parents and families to enable all the children to achieve their full potential.

We annually adopt the Constitution from The Preschool Alliance as our governing document. We have a full range of governing policies, all of which are adopted annually by as committee and always accessible to all parents either in paper form or by accessing them online at any convenient time.

During this year we have run **190** sessions and have a handful of children who are using the 30 hour funding available to working parents. The majority of our families live in the local area and are in receipt of 2 year funding and or three year Government funding. We still continue the wraparound

service offering childcare from 08.30 – 2.30pm. The preschool is based in a considered area of deprivation and with that in mind we try to keep the fees at an affordable rate for all families. For us being able to offer good quality affordable childcare in a home from home environment is what matters.

We are always giving out information to parents on the different funding available and the criteria to be eligible especially where the different funding is concerned. We are continuing to offer the 30 hour funding as we want to offer the service to our parents. However we do realise this initially may be at a loss to us as it is still not being taken up to its fullest capacity. We have found some parents are not sure of the criteria to be eligible or would like to receive it but do not work enough hours to get it.

We do offer extra sessions when we have them and parents pay for the fees if they take extra hours. This is dependent on who is off on that day through illness or holidays etc. Since Covid we are aware of the financial struggles families are facing and the higher prices of food. However, we still supply snack for the children as we know how important this is especially for families that are really struggling with their finances.

We have put a few of our families in touch with local food banks and also given out food care packages where we can as well as being their for parents that have struggled with their mental health during the past 18 months. Trying to offer a listening ear and to signpost parents to where they can get more help.

We are a small setting and feel we are a depended and necessary service provider to all of our families in the local deprived area. The majority of staff live in the local community and together we genuinely care about the families and neighbourhood.

Within our committee we select a chair person, Treasurer and secretary, we ask for members to come forward and then they are nominated and seconded by other members of the committee who are all volunteers to the committee.

We are allowed 30 spaces a day and currently have 29 filled leaving one space for any emergency that our local authority may need to place with us.

We open in line with schools and follow the same holidays as Hampshire County Council.

We provide sessions from 9am till 2.30pm We did until Covid-19 provide a breakfast club starting at 8.30am and when things Covid-19 related have settled down will return to offer this.

We have invested a lot of money into our garden as we realise the area we are catchment in, not all our children have access to gardens or such equipment that we have been able to provide.

We have also purchased a lot of playzone/softplay equipment that we are able to offer our children the risk and challenge they need and also help with balance and Gross Motor Skills.

Our main source of income is from the Gov grants of 15hrs and 30hrs funding.

Children bring in their own lunches but we do provide a snack at break times.

Within our committee we select a chair person, Treasurer and secretary, we ask for members to come forward and then they are nominated and seconded by other members of the committee who are all volunteers to the committee.

We are allowed 30 spaces a day and currently have 29 filled leaving one space for any emergency that our local authority may need to place with us.

We open in line with schools and follow the same holidays as Hampshire County Council.

We provide sessions from 9am till 2.30pm We did until Covid-19 provide a breakfast club starting at 8.30am and when things Covid-19 related have settled down will return to offer this.

We have invested a lot of money into our garden as we realise the area we are catchment in, not all our children have access to gardens or such equipment that we have been able to provide.

We have also purchased a lot of playzone/softplay equipment that we are able to offer our children the risk and challenge they need and also help with balance and Gross Motor Skills.

Our main source of income is from the Gov grants of 15hrs and 30hrs funding.

Children bring in their own lunches but we do provide a snack at break times.
