REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

FOR THE PERIOD FROM 19TH MAY 2020 TO 18TH MAY 2021

THE OBJECT OF THE TRUST

The object of the Trust is exclusively to raise funds for the preservation and maintenance of the fabric, interior decorations and furnishings of the Parish Church in Mayfield. To this end, the Trust invites individuals and organisations to become members making annual donations to the Charity. The Trust is also keen to attract larger sums for either general applications to the objects of the Trust or for specific projects to be agreed with the donor.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The financial result for the period is stated in the income and expenditure account attached.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

Income for this year was £55,703 (2020 - £5,640). Despite the vicissitudes of COVID-19 constraints which precluded our usual garden party contribution, we were fortunate to benefit from a donation of £1,500 from our former bank provider, Natwest, on transferring our account to Co-op Bank and the generosity of the Biron Family for the collection at the funeral of Moreen Biron, for long a supporter of the Charity and for a number of years until her death in early 2020 a Trustee. We also received a large bequest of £30,000 from the estate of one of the earliest life members of the charity.

During the year, as a function of the delays imposed upon the Church PCC by COVID-19, we have not made any payments to the Church. We have however committed to fund work at completion of the internal cleaning and repairs to the tower to a total of about £15,000. I am pleased to report that this project has now been satisfactorily completed.


Lastly, the Friends have said goodbye to Fr Nigel in July 2020 on his departure from the Parish for his new post in Suffolk. On behalf of the Trust I would like to thank him for his contributions over the years and we wish him well in his new parish.

Over the last 23 years, the charity has raised over £217,000 to support the PCC in its endeavours to preserve the fabric of the Church. The Trustees are most grateful to members for their ongoing support.

RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY OF TRUSTEES AND AUDITORS




