History, objectives and activities of the Trust

The Charitable Trust was established on 1 July 1993 to operate the charitable activities of the Rotary Club of Nailsea and Backwell.

The Trust Deed gives the trustees the power to apply the funds in such manner as they think fit to or for the relief of the poor and needy or to or for such other charitable purpose, institution, society or objective as the Club shall in duly constituted meetings from time to time direct.

The Club identifies each year some specific charities and projects which it wishes to support and raises funds specifically for these, and these are reported as Restricted activities.

The Club also undertakes charitable fund raising activities to enable other grants and payments to be made and these are decided by the Club Council as and when requests for assistance are received.

Management and governance arrangements

The trust deed provides for 4 trustees, being the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Rotary Club.

The treasurer is responsible for the induction of new trustees which involves awareness of a trustee's responsibilities, the governing document and administrative procedures.

No specific risks have been identified following the annual review of risks.

Public benefit

In planning our activities and making decisions on grants throughout the year we have kept in mind the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

The focus of our grants remains on providing funds to charities operating for the benefit of people in North Somerset and neighbouring localities re health and welfare; assisting young people in educational and self development activities and in particular individuals who may not have the financial means to undertake such activities; providing financial assistance to victims of humanitarian disasters.

The other significant benefit provided is through the annual Charity Walks which gives local charities the opportunity to raise funds by participating in this event.

Restricted activities. A Charity Walk facilitated a wide range of fundraising for many local charities and Rotary projects – in total over £30,000.

Unrestricted activities. Various fund raising events continue to support local schools, Disaster Appeals also youth and community needs. Unrestricted Fund cash balance was £3641.17 at the end of the year

Financial review, investment policy and reserves

All Trust funds are retained in bank accounts with Barclays Bank PLC thereby minimizing any investment risk. The club targets to hold a minimum cash reserve of £1000.

There was a net reduction in total resources in the year of £13213.62.

There is continuing focus on help and support in the community – particularly youth related. The Club will continue to support Rotary Foundation.

Future Plans

There is increasing focus on help and support in the community – particularly youth related. The Club will continue to support Rotary Foundation. The Covid pandemic has resulted in reducing some of our fund raising activities.

prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate that the charity will continue in operational existence.

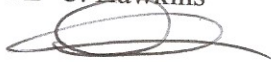

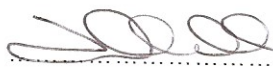
