Treasurer's Report
Sept 2024 – Aug 2025

The total expenditure for the last financial year 2024/2025 was £84,457 which was £12,701 more than the previous year (£71,756) this is mainly due to the increase in the wages which alone was £16,605 more between 2024/2025 than in 2023/2024.

However the total income for the last financial year 2024/2025 was £110,320 which was £22,301 more than the previous financial year (2023/2024) which was £88,019. The two main increases in income were in fees and government funding – totalling £103,455 alone – but we were at capacity on numbers throughout the year with the majority of children government funded which allowed for the increase in income.

This all resulted in an overall profit of £25,863 in financial year 2024/2025, meaning that we had a total of £66,366 in the bank account at the end of August 2025.

Last financial year (2023/2024) saw us receive only £1945 in donations and fundraising however this financial year (2024/2025) £5,126 was raised in donations and fundraising, mainly thanks to the efforts of the committee with events like mothers day, raffles and sports day which in total raised £1,641 and the sterling efforts of Robyn Lamborune in obtaining grants totalling £3,485.

I believe we do need to consider similar fundraising events in 2025/2026 and apply for any grants/donations which we can use to help further improve the financial situation of Cherry Tree Pre-school. I suggest that we identify a few committee members to focus on fundraising this academic year and also a member of staff to lead the grants a donations efforts.

Overall this report is positive and Cherry Tree is in a good place, and it is certainly financially better off than this time last year, however the current situation is that the government funding received each month is currently only really covering the basic wages, NI and pension contributions of the members of staff we currently employ and then we have the general running and maintenance costs of the pre-school on-top such as air conditioning servicing, fire extinguishers, first aid courses, electrical checks, general supplies, and sudden bills and the list continues. We also need some reserves for redundancy pay should this ever occur.

We also need to bare in mind that the minimum wage will go up again in April 2026, so this will increase our monthly wage costs again further, also we have less children enrolled with us currently than we did in September 2024, however I am sure this will pick up in the new year as it normally does.

In summary we need to ensure that the money received from government funding and fees is higher than what we spend in wages, hopefully with the same focus as last year on grants/donations and fundraising this can help cover some of the other costs of running the pre-school without dipping too much into the savings which need to remain around the level they are at, to be able to safely and comfortably continue to run Cherry Tree Pre-school into the future.

The total expenditure for the last financial year 2023-2024 was £71,746 which was £13,174 more than the previous year (£58,572) this is mainly due to the increase in the wages which alone was £14,607 more between 2023 and 2024 than in 2022/2023.

However the total income for the last financial year 2023-2024 was £87,817 which was £39,049 more than the previous financial year (2022-2023) which was £48,768. The two main increases in income were in Fees (£17,280) and government funding (£25,569) – but we did have a lot of children (too many).

This all resulted in an overall profit of £16,071 in financial year 2023-2024, meaning that we had £39,120 in the bank account at the end of August 2024.

Last financial year (2022/2023) saw us receive £5242 in donations and fundraising however this financial year (2023-2024) only £1945 was raised in donations and fundraising. Therefore we do need to consider some fundraising events in 2024/2025 and apply for any grants/donations which we can to help improve the financial situation and to do this I suggest that we identify a few committee members to look into grants and fundraising this academic year.

Overall this report might seem that Cherry Tree is in a good place, and it is certainly financially better off than this time last year, however the current situation is that the government funding received each month is currently only just covering the basic wages of the 5 members of staff we currently employ and then we have the general running and maintenance costs of the pre-school on-top such as air conditioning servicing, fire extinguishers, first aid courses, electrical checks, general supplies, and sudden bills and the list continues. We also need some reserves for redundancy pay should this ever occur.

We also need to bare in mind that the minimum wage will go up again in April 2024 by about £1 and hour – so this will increase our wage monthly costs again.

In summary we need to try and break even this year between government funding and wages, then hopefully and grants/donations and fundraising can help cover some of the other costs of running the pre-school without dipping too much into the savings which need to remain around the level they are at to be able to comfortably continue to run Cherry Tree Pre-school.

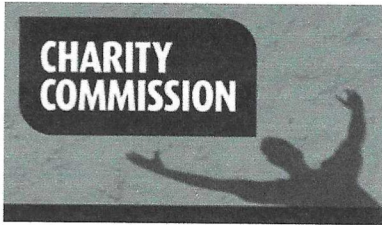

Review of the Year

Last financial year (Sept 2022 until Aug 2023) saw us receive £2695.80 in fundraising and grants and donations, £1892.10 of that was raised from the very first Cherry Tree Pre-School fete which was a great success and raised more than expected.

The total expenditure for the last financial year 2022-2023 was £58,571.99 which was similar to year ending August 2022 (£55,596.30) however the total income for the last financial year 2022-2023 was £15,361.57 less than in 2012-2022, this was really due to the lack of numbers in the 2022-2023 academic year.

Therefore in summary for 2022-2023 income was £48,768.20 but expenditure was £58,571.99 – therefore we made a loss of £9803.79 – we need to keep an eye on this deficit in 2023-2024, however it is already looking better as we have a lot more children registered and attending cherry tree in academic year 2023-2024 than in academic year 2022-2023.

Reserves

The Trustees financial aim each year is to have a year-end figure in the bank account high enough to cover the overheads and wages of the pre-school for a minimum of 4 months. We have continued to have the funds in the account to meet this aim.

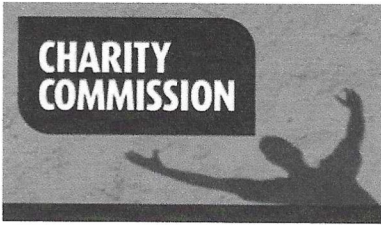
