The Stamford House Trust is constituted by Deed of Trust and is a registered charity 1039148. Its address is Tregleah, North Downs, Scorrier, Redruth, Cornwall, TR16 5BT. The charity trustees during the year to 5th April 2021 were:

The objects of the charity are the advancement of the Christian Religion and the Relief of the poor and needy. This is achieved by making grants to other relevant charitable organizations and by grants to individuals.

The funds to make grants are obtained exclusively from voluntary donations under deeds of covenant and the gift aid scheme. The trustees do not anticipate this method of financing to alter.

It was confirmed during the year that the trustees of Westbury Trust, all of whom are also trustees of this trust, had resolved to close Westbury Trust as at 31st March 2021 and transfer the assets and liabilities to Stamford House Trust. The objects of Westbury Trust are the advancement of the Christian Religion as are those of Stamford House. The assets of Westbury Trust are far in excess of the liabilities.

During the year the trustees resolved to change the trusts bankers from Barclays to NatWest and this was accomplished in August 2020.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF
STAMFORD HOUSE TRUST

I report to the trustees on my examination of the accounts of Stamford House Trust for the period ended 5th April 2021 which are set out on pages 3 to 5.

Respective Responsibilities of trustees and examiner


