Para 1.20	<p>Merry Go Round preschool had a strong year in 2021-2022 with limited disruptions from COVID-19. The number of children attending the setting has increased with an influx of families to the area following the COVID-19 pandemic. Our strong ethos and the style of the setting has meant that the preschool has been a popular choice for new parents, with many placing their children on a waiting list for future spaces at the setting.</p> <p>Our fundraising activities included a very successful Christmas Fair where funds were raised for a new greenhouse and vegetable garden with raised beds. This facility is designed to encourage the children to grow and care for living things as well as to gain a better understanding of where food comes from and how to cook food grown in the garden. This new facility fits well with our ethos of play-based learning.</p>

		Our forest school has continued to be very popular, and this fits in perfectly with our ethos of encouraging outdoor play. The same can be said for our wonderful garden.

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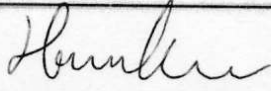

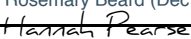

Where incoming resources have related expenditure (as with fundraising or contract income) the incoming resources and related expenditure are reported gross in the SoFA.

**Grants and donations**

Grants and donations are only included in the SoFA when the charity has unconditional entitlement to the resources.

**Tax reclaims on donations and gifts**

Incoming resources from tax reclaims are included in the SoFA at the same time as the gift to which they relate.

**Contractual income and performance related grants**

**Gifts in kind**

Gifts in kind are accounted for at a reasonable estimate of their value to the charity or the amount actually realised.

Gifts in kind for sale or distribution are included in the accounts as gifts only when sold or distributed by the charity.

Gifts in kind for use by the charity are included in the SoFA as incoming resources when receivable.

**Donated services and facilities**

These are only included in incoming resources (with an equivalent amount in resources expended) where the benefit to the charity is reasonably quantifiable, measurable and material. The value placed on these resources is the estimated value to the charity of the service or facility received.

**Volunteer help**

The value of any voluntary help received is not included in the accounts but is described in the trustees' annual report.

**Investment income**

This is included in the accounts when receivable.

**Investment gains and losses**

This includes any gain or loss on the sale of investments and any gain or loss resulting from revaluing investments to market value at the end of the year.

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.

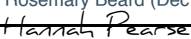
