The Rotary club is governed by it's constitution, and by Rotary International. The Trustees are selected by election from the membership of the Rotary club, and the Trustee fund is administered by the Trustees and the committee council of the club. All decisions relating to distribution of funds from the Trust Fund are made by the members of the club subsequent to ratification by club council. Council includes the Trustees and the chairmen of all the various committees that make up the Rotary club. Minutes are taken at all Club Council meetings, and the club has a business night every 4-6 weeks, where discussions are held in committees that then forward their suggestions to the Club Council, meeting the following week, where the final decisions are made. All cheques require counter-signature.

The fund-raising aim of this Rotary club is for general charitable purpose. This Trust fund helps young people, the elderly, and other chairies and voluntary bodied. The club makes grants to organisations, and provides services.


The major fund-raising events that provide the income for the Rotary club of Lichfield St Chad are **Rotary Cars in the Park**, and **Cathedral to Castle Run**. The latter is managed jointly with three other Rotary clubs.

Obviously, the pandemic has curtailed a lot of activity and income is reduced accordingly.

Lichfield St Chad Rotary club supports the Lichfield Police Cadets, Lichfield Talking Newspapers (a serve for the blind), British Heart Foundation, Shelter Box (emergency accommodation for families worldwide) aquabox, Menigitis Now, St Mary's centre Lichfield, and We Love Lichfield, amongst others.

All funds raised are distributed to help others, for general charitable purposes.
