OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The charity is constituted under a trust deed dated 1st September 1994 and is a registered charity number 1041027.

The objectives of the charity as set out in the Declaration of Trust are:

- (a) The advancement of the Christian faith,
- (b) The relief of persons who are in conditions of hardship or distress or who are aged or sick and
- (c) The relief of poverty.

The church was involved in Christian outreach programmes designed to increase Christian awareness and to spread the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The trustees have considered the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit, including the guidance 'public benefit: running a charity (PB2)'.

The Trustees are pleased to report that the church continued to be successful spiritually by ministering to many people. We became a registered charity on 4th October 1994.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The net incoming resources for the year amounted to a surplus of £1162. The previous year was £6397 deficit, which was attributable to general reserves.

1. Accounting Policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, except for investments which are included at market value and the revaluation of certain fixed assets and in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102), and the Charities Act 2011.

CHRIST REVELATION FAITH MINISTRIES meets the definition of a public benefit entity under FRS 102. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy note(s).

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the Charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income:

Tithes & Offerings:- Income from tithes and offering is included in incoming resources when these are receivable. The Charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No 1 from the requirement to produce cashflow statement on the grounds that it qualifies as a small charity.

Investment Income:- Investment income consists of interest received during the period.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.
