**DSA Chair Report 2020**

- DSAUK continues to develop and grow, both in terms of membership numbers and the offer to our members, families and groups we support.

**Membership**

- Membership increased by **40 full members** and **160 associates** during 2020, taking the association to **2511** members in total of which **806** are full RG members who we support by providing regular sporting and recreational activities helping to improve self-esteem, physical fitness health and wellbeing.

**DSAUK Regions**

- **DSAUK** does this by providing regular sporting and recreational activities through our regional structure. DSAUK delivers a broad range of sporting events and social activities as well as engaging the local communities through our schools and community group programme.
- During 2020 DSAUK regions organised over 180 events, including
  - ✓ 169 Sporting events
  - ✓ Reached over 3,000 pupils and teachers through our schools' programme

### **DSAUK Regions (continued)**

- **DSAUK** continued to play an active role in national campaigns to increase access to sport and recreational activities for disabled people
- Partnering with the Activity Alliance we commissioned a research piece on the benefits of recreational activity and independent living, which was published in early 2020, gaining positive media coverage across the UK.
- **DSAUK** works in partnership with both 'Little People UK' and 'Restricted Growth Association' attending conferences, running sporting events for their members and engaging in joint projects to raise awareness of the barriers and issues faced by dwarfs and people with restricted growth conditions.

### **Creating New Opportunities**

- **DSAUK** works at creating different opportunities for its members and associates to engage in sport, recreation and personal development.
- DSAUK enables new and existing members to move from inactive to active citizens by offering a mixed programme of sporting and recreational events, including
- **Cage cricket:** A dynamic, visually exciting sport aimed at engaging and embracing members into the DSA family

**Recreational Activity Weekend**, aimed at building individual self-esteem and sense of independence for members across the age group.


### **Grant Funding**

- DSAUK relies on grant funding to support and fund our staff positions and are grateful for the continued support from Children In Need, Sport England and the We all Make a Difference Charity.
- Our renewed partnership with Children In Need enables us to deliver a comprehensive programme of community based sporting and recreational events for those children who would otherwise struggle to access sporting activities .

### **Reserve Funds**

- The DSA has several reserve funds. A £20,000 reserve to secure the associations event programme if funding is not found.
- A DSAUK core cost reserve, representing one year's overhead cover of £24,000.
- A reserve fund of £20,694 as a contingency fund if the charity has a period of time when staff funding is not available and finally

**NOTES TO STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL ACTIVITIES (SOFA)**  
**YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 2020**

**1. THE BASIS OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND DEFINITIONS**

- 1.1 THE ACCOUNTS** have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable accounting standards and the Charities Act 2006 and Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) 2005.
- 1.2 GENERAL FUNDS** represent unrestricted funds that are not subject to any restriction regarding their use and are available for application towards their use purposes of a general nature.
- 1.3 RESTRICTED FUNDS** represent funds restricted by the donor for a particular purpose.
- 1.3(a) DESIGNATED FUNDS** represent funds that have been allocated out of Unrestricted funds by the Trustees of DSAuk, for specific events or liabilities DSAuk is committed to. Any remaining balance is returned to unrestricted funds when events have been held.
- 1.4 INCOMING RESOURCES** are included in the SOFA when:-
- DSAuk becomes entitled to the resources
  - The trustees are virtually certain they will receive the resources; and
  - The monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability.
- 1.5 GRANTS & DONATIONS** are included in the SOFA when DSAuk has unconditional entitlement to the resources.
- 1.6 INVESTMENT INCOME** is included in the SOFA when receivable.
- 1.7 RESOURCES EXPENDED** are recognised when costs have been incurred, or for designated or special gifts, in the same accounting period as the related gift is received.
- 1.8 TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS** are capitalised at cost when incurred, or for assets bought in previous years, at valuation in 2020. The valuation of assets from previous years was identified as income, in Voluntary Incoming Resources.
- 1.9 DEPRECIATION OF FIXED ASSETS** is included in resources expended, to write off the assets of over their useful life, - 3 years for Bikes & 4 years for other equipment.
- 1.10 LIABILITY RECOGNITION** – Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.
- 1.11 GOVERNANCE COSTS** – The preparation & examination of DSAuk's annual statutory accounts, AGM & trustee meeting expenses; also legal advice given to trustees.

- *During the year £ Nil (2019: - £ NIL) was transferred to CAF deposit account for Sport England.*
- *During the year, the North West Region transferred funds to Head Office towards their region's costs of attending the next World Dwarf Games, amounting to £6,300.*
- *These funds are allocated out of Unrestricted Funds for the stated events or purposes.*
- *DSAUK core cost reserve represents the estimated annual overheads to run the charity.*
- *Any surpluses will transfer back into Unrestricted Funds, for use within the Charity.*

**8. NON-ADJUSTING POST BALANCE SHEET EVENTS – COVID 19**

- Coronavirus was declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organisation on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020. As a result of this and social distancing rules, all DSAuk events from this date were postponed and/or cancelled.
- For the purpose of these accounts, we have treated coronavirus as a non-adjusting post balance sheet event. These accounts have been prepared using asset valuations as at 31 December 2020.
- There have been no adverse effects in terms of the receipt of restricted funding from Children in Need and Sport England, which has been received as expected in 2020.
- Any further impact of Coronavirus will be reflected in the accounts for the current year, ended 31 December 2020, and also 2021, where many events continue to be cancelled or postponed. It is hoped that towards the end of 2021 and into 2022 DSAuk will be able to begin again to put on some regional and national events.

*I report on the accounts of the Association for the Year Ended to 31st DECEMBER 2020, as shown on pages 4 – 10 attached.*

**RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRUSTEES AND EXAMINER**

*The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 (the Charities Act) and that an independent examination is needed. It is my responsibility to:-*

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the Charities Act*
- to follow the procedures laid down in the General Directions given by the Charity Commission (under section 145(5)(b) of the Charities Act), and*
- to state whether particular matters have come to my attention*

**BASIS OF INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT**

*My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters.
