Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 31 October 2024

The trust was formed to provide a widespread family of supporters for Thaxted parish church. Our purpose is two-fold, (i) to preserve and restore the fabric, furnishings and facilities of the church and (ii) to support and promote the activities of the church within the community.

We work closely with the Parochial Church Council through a newly developed joint working party, chaired by Rev. Christopher Brown. We are currently involved in three projects:-

- The Becket chapel parapet. £10k was originally pledged. Delays and inflation will nearly double this figure. It forms an item on our May meeting where we hope to sign off our funding commitment.
- The Lighting Project. This is at an advanced stage and we will be discussing the implications in May.
- The Holst/Moorcroft window. The project has many hurdles to negotiate and we will keep progress under review.
- Raising funds to meet these and other potential projects forms a vital part of our work.
- Annual subscriptions: these form an important part of our funding. They have been static for some time and we probably need to look at this area afresh.
- Funds raised by our working party. Despite Covid restrictions, the total raised for the year was £7669.58. In addition, £618.85 was raised for the Salvation Army Christmas appeal at the Town Carol Service.

The total end of year figure for FoTC funds was £143,596

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
