The Trustees present their report and the financial statements of the Trust for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.

#### **LEGAL STATUS**

The Labone Charitable Trust is constituted by a Deed of Trust dated 3<sup>rd</sup> November 1994 and is a registered charity, No. 1042836.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST**

The Trust was established to promote religion, relief of poverty and other objects agreed by the Trustees.

The Trustees during the year were Mr A A Stiegler, Mrs A B Stiegler and Mr C J Young, who are also directors of R A Labone & Co. Ltd., and Mrs M Cummins. Mr A A Stiegler and Mr C J Young are also directors of Labone Holdings Ltd. There were no changes of Trustee during the year.

#### **REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES**

As shown in the accounts the trustees endeavour to distribute all of the income of the Trust in the year it is received. As a result the only assets of the charity are the shareholding in Labone Holdings Ltd. and bank balances. The main benefactor of the Trust for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022 was Kukura Neshungu Institute to whom donations of £9,971 were made.

#### **INCOME**

The income received during the year under review amounted to £30,100

#### **RESULTS**

The results for the year and the Trust's financial position at the end of the year are shown in the attached financial statements.

- To state whether particular matters have come to my attention.


**BASIS OF INDEPENDENT EXAMINERS STATEMENT**


