Organisational structure includes the annual trustee meeting to discuss the requirements of the school and to ensure the requirements are aligned with the charity's objectives. This is then communicated to the volunteers and reviewed when a request for the charity to purchase items agreed with the school is made.

Financial controls include the following:

No funds are released without the consent of the trustees and all expense payments are agreed prior to purchases made. Expenses are reimbursed on the production of a valid receipt. All receipts are kept and tied with bank transactions.

To advance the education of the pupils of the school by providing and assisting in the provision of facilities for education at the school, which are not normally provided by the local authority.

To foster more extended relationships between staff, parents and others associated with the school and Engage in activities, which support the school and advance the education of the children attending it.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

The trustees of the charity are aware of the guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission and seek to benefit the public through the pursuit of the objectives stated in the charity constitution.

For financial year ending 31st August 2020, many of the events were affected or cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The events that the charity were able to run included the Christmas Bazaar, Christmas and Spring Disco – these were attended and supported by the local community both in attendance and by local businesses therefore strengthening community cohesion and ties.

The Charity purchased interactive TV's (Bushmead TV) which provide information to the parents regarding both school and events taking place within the community and has been a tool to further enhance the educational experience of the pupils which otherwise would not have been available to them.

Friends of Bushmead School, with the support of a grant awarded to the charity were able to purchase a canopy for the school. Which enabled the school to increase floor space for the pupils, who now enjoy an 'outdoor learning space' within the school itself.

The charity was able to purchase new garden and PE equipment for all year groups which otherwise would not have been available to the children. Ensuring a wider variety of active learning through play and teaching the children about the environment through afterschool clubs. These resources were purchased by the charity, this was supported by the staff who were able to identify the equipment needed within the year groups.

Friends of Bushmead School have benefitted from an increase in grants awarded to the charity.

In terms of the policy towards application of grants, there is no written policy in place.

Though the following contribution outlined by a charity volunteer highlights the process of grant making undertaken:

The volunteer reaches out to the school regarding an available grant. The school then will advise what they would like the charity to apply for and what the public benefit would be.

The information is reviewed by the trustees and ensured that both the public benefit and the objectives of the charity are met prior to consent being given to the volunteer to apply on behalf of the charity.

The charity enjoys significant support from both school and parent volunteers. The school host many of the meetings and events, whilst also supporting during the events. The parent volunteers also help with managing of events and liaising with the school regarding advertising and volunteering. Therefore, ensuring the objective of *extended relationships between staff, parents* outlined in the constitution's objectives is met.

Section D

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The charity raised £5.9K from fundraising activities throughout the year. The charity's ability to raise funds this year was affected by the global pandemic, which meant the larger events such as the summer fair, father's day shop and disco did not take place. The activities that did take place included the following:

- Christmas Bazaar
- Clothes recycling
- Christmas and Spring Discos

The Charity was awarded numerous grants during the year which totalled £17.9k including:

- Luton London Airport £7.5K
- Magic Grant £500
- Gale Grant £2.5K
- Aviva Grant £1.5k
- Library Grant £5k

The financial performance of the charity exceeded our expectations for the year in terms of grants awarded which offset some of the reduction in income from the reduced events timetable and where expenditure was higher. As many items were purchased during the Christmas sales for summer events that were then subsequently cancelled.

The main achievements in the year were the completion of the installation of the canopy in Year 1 quad area. Where the charity was able to fund £7.5k with a grant secured for an additional £7.5k for the £15k canopy.

The continued support of Bushmead TV and purchasing of resources for the gardening club. However, any further purchases for the school did not take place due to the sudden closure of schools across the country. Though the charity was able to fulfil any agreed financial commitments in the year such as funding Bushmead TV.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The charity does not have a policy on reserves. Currently for the year ending 31 August 2020, there is a carry forward reserve of £18,933.

Of these reserves £9864 are restricted funds awarded for specific projects such as BSA Science (£300), Love Luton (£3000) and KS2 Library funds (£5k) yet to be undertaken,

The charity has also allocated a further £5000 for future commitments agreed by the trustees for the KS2 Library.

Therefore, leaving a contingency of £4k to cover events pre costs and any costs arising in 2020/21, as we are expecting a further drop in events income due to the current pandemic restrictions.

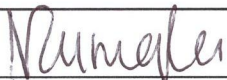

The trustees of the charity are aware of the guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission and seek to benefit the public through the pursuit of the objectives stated in the charity constitution.

For financial year ending 31st August 2020, many of the events were affected or cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The events that the charity were able to run included the Christmas Bazaar, Christmas and Spring Disco – these were attended and supported by the local community both in attendance and by local businesses therefore strengthening community cohesion and ties.

The Charity purchased interactive TV's (Bushmead TV) which provide information to the parents regarding both school and events taking place within the community and has been a tool to further enhance the educational experience of the pupils which otherwise would not have been available to them.

Friends of Bushmead School, with the support of a grant awarded to the charity were able to purchase a canopy for the school. Which enabled the school to increase floor space for the pupils, who now enjoy an 'outdoor learning space' within the school itself.

The charity was able to purchase new garden and PE equipment for all year groups which otherwise would not have been available to the children. Ensuring a wider variety of active learning through play and teaching the children about the environment through afterschool clubs. These resources were purchased by the charity, this was supported by the staff who were able to identify the equipment needed within the year groups.

Friends of Bushmead School have benefitted from an increase in grants awarded to the charity.

In terms of the policy towards application of grants, there is no written policy in place.

Though the following contribution outlined by a charity volunteer highlights the process of grant making undertaken:

The volunteer reaches out to the school regarding an available grant. The school then will advise what they would like the charity to apply for and what the public benefit would be.

The information is reviewed by the trustees and ensured that both the public benefit and the objectives of the charity are met prior to consent being given to the volunteer to apply on behalf of the charity.

The charity enjoys significant support from both school and parent volunteers. The school host many of the meetings and events, whilst also supporting during the events. The parent volunteers also help with managing of events and liaising with the school regarding advertising and volunteering. Therefore, ensuring the objective of *extended relationships between staff, parents* outlined in the constitution's objectives is met.

Section D

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The charity raised £5.9K from fundraising activities throughout the year. The charity's ability to raise funds this year was affected by the global pandemic, which meant the larger events such as the summer fair, father's day shop and disco did not take place. The activities that did take place included the following:

- Christmas Bazaar
- Clothes recycling
- Christmas and Spring Discos

The Charity was awarded numerous grants during the year which totalled £17.9k including:

- Luton London Airport £7.5K
- Magic Grant £500
- Gale Grant £2.5K
- Aviva Grant £1.5k
- Library Grant £5k

The financial performance of the charity exceeded our expectations for the year in terms of grants awarded which offset some of the reduction in income from the reduced events timetable and where expenditure was higher. As many items were purchased during the Christmas sales for summer events that were then subsequently cancelled.

The main achievements in the year were the completion of the installation of the canopy in Year 1 quad area. Where the charity was able to fund £7.5k with a grant secured for an additional £7.5k for the £15k canopy.

The continued support of Bushmead TV and purchasing of resources for the gardening club. However, any further purchases for the school did not take place due to the sudden closure of schools across the country. Though the charity was able to fulfil any agreed financial commitments in the year such as funding Bushmead TV.

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The charity does not have a policy on reserves. Currently for the year ending 31 August 2020, there is a carry forward reserve of £18,933.

Of these reserves £9864 are restricted funds awarded for specific projects such as BSA Science (£300), Love Luton (£3000) and KS2 Library funds (£5k) yet to be undertaken,

The charity has also allocated a further £5000 for future commitments agreed by the trustees for the KS2 Library.

Therefore, leaving a contingency of £4k to cover events pre costs and any costs arising in 2020/21, as we are expecting a further drop in events income due to the current pandemic restrictions.

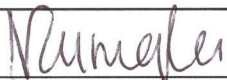
