In 2022 this included work by Alex Merritt & Steve Fishwick, Tom Ollendorff & Ben Wendel, Tom Green, Soft Machine, Ivo Neame, Tomasso Starace, Matt Ridley, Arun Ghosh, Zoë Gilby, and Mike & Kate Westbrook.

During the year the Trust's financial position was stable, incoming donations allowing the support of two large-scale works by Mike Westbrook, but it remains dependent upon donations for its future work. Other activities during 2022 began to recover from the coronavirus pandemic, but had not reached pre-pandemic levels.
