In July 2025, the charity received a one-off transfer of £25,125.13 from Triplett's Community Tennis Centre following the closure of the club. The transfer was made as the club's operational contract expired, and remaining funds were transferred to Dr Triplett's Fund.

The trustees agreed that these funds would be used to support the charity's objectives, specifically to invest in the improvement of school sports facilities, including the development of new tennis court surfaces. This initiative aims to promote healthy lifestyles, physical activity, and sports education for pupils and the wider local community.

This transfer represents a significant proportion of the charity's income for the year and is not expected to recur in future reporting periods.
