**INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES AND MEMBERS OF
THE FRIENDS OF KIRKHAM GRAMMAR SCHOOL**

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31 July 2022.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner
