In the UK, we taught several *One for Life* and *Married for Life* courses to couples across the UK, in English and Portuguese. These courses are taught online as well as face to face. We also taught our *Deepening Love* weekend course to couples from England and Portugal. We have approximately 40 leadership couples in the UK. The work in Europe is growing significantly particularly in Portugal and we are establishing 2=1 in several new European countries including France, Luxembourg, Belgium and The Netherlands.

Over the past few years we have updated our website to allow for online registration, payment and reporting. We continue to upload our manuals in the various European languages so courses can be done without paper manuals.

We often have online prayer meetings and conferences for couples across Europe.

Directors Roles

Mr and Mrs Thomas have been the UK Directors for 2=1 since 2008 and in October 2015 became the International Directors, Europe. This means that they generally travel to Europe as needed to visit the couples leading 2=1 in other European countries, as well as leading the work across Europe, which includes establishing the ministry in more European countries and running conferences and ministry weekends.

We occasionally travel to other continents to teach leaders, particularly for the *Deepening Love* weekend course. In the last few years we have taught this in New Zealand, Malaysia, Australia and most recently in South Africa.

We have approximately 40 leadership couples.

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Expansion in Role

This means that they have travelled to Europe several times a year (outside of the pandemic) to visit the couples leading 2=1 in other European countries. We currently teach in 13 European countries and now also have opportunities to expand into other European countries including France, Sweden, Norway and Austria. Since March 2020 the vast majority of our work had been online, but this has returned to teaching courses in person over the past year or so.

We occasionally travel to other continents to teach leaders, particularly for our new Deepening Love course. In the last few years we have taught in New Zealand, Malaysia, Australia and this year in South Africa.
