It has been my privilege to continue to serve as the pastor at Emmanuel Pentecostal Church in Gateshead since February 2020, and although I will reach retirement age in February 2026, during this financial year I offered to remain in the pastoral role for another year up until February 2027, which the trustees and leadership of the Church agreed to.

It has been another busy year which saw us grow numerically, as we have continued with our weekly activity. We decided part way through this financial year to amalgamate our two midweek services which were a prayer meeting on the Wednesday evening and a ministry meeting on a Friday evening into one service, which is held on a Friday evening and includes both a time for prayer and ministry., we have continued to hold two Sunday services, one in the morning and the other in the evening. The Sunday morning service is our most attended service as we join for praise, communion and ministry, the first Sunday morning of the month is given over to a family service, catering more towards the children and young people who attend.

Once a month a ladies fellowship is held, and weekly on a Wednesday except during the summer school holidays a coffee morning.

Over the financial year we have given financial support to Platform 67, The Christian Institute and Claire Kinkead Junction Church in Jamaica, we also sent an additional contribution to Junction Church following the hurricane that had caused so much damage.

Additionally, we made a financial contribution following our Carol Service to Mission without borders and also from our coffee mornings a donation of £150 to Crohn's and Colitis UK, we have also continued to support the Gateshead foodbank throughout the year and during our harvest thanksgiving we collected 75KG of various food and hygiene items which we donated to them.

We had a considerable expense during the year as our roof became damaged and needed to be replaced, but this cost was covered through a legacy that was given to the Church by a member who had died a year previously.

During this year we have sought to continue to meet our object which is to preach the good news of the gospel, and to meet the spiritual needs of those who attend on a regular basis.

As a Church we have continued throughout the last twelve months for this report to hold our regular services, which on a weekly basis consist of a worship and communion service on a Sunday morning and a gospel service on the Sunday evening, with a prayer meeting on a Wednesday evening, where we not only pray for the needs of the local church, but also for our local community, national needs and world mission. Then on a Friday evening we hold a Bible Study evening.

We held a coffee morning every Wednesday morning (except during August and into the early part of September as a means of outreach to our local community, from the coffee mornings we raised funds for Macmillan cancer.

We also continued during this year to support a local food bank in the town of Gateshead, we had a harvest thanksgiving in October and all the produce was given to the foodbank.

We held a carol service and together with a carol service held in our building by St John Ambulance, we raised money for the Children's Hospital at the RVI in Newcastle.

We still produce a regular video to send out to those who are unable to attend the Church fellowship, and the pastor still sends out a daily devotion for all who wish to receive it, a practise which was started at the beginning of the first Covid lockdown.

During September we lost one of our founding members who died at the age of 98.

Two were added to the makeup of our Trustees, Iain Cairns and Haydn Greenow.

We also commenced to run our Coffee Morning on a weekly basis rather than bi-weekly which are intended to be a form of outreach into the local community.

We have continued during this year to support a local food bank in the town of Gateshead, and we regularly hold a gospel service on the Sunday evening with the purpose of reaching our local community with the gospel.

We still produce a regular video to send out to those who are unable to attend the Church fellowship, and the pastor still sends out a daily devotion for all who wish to receive it, a practise which was started at the beginning of the first lockdown.

We have begun to see an increase in the number of those attending the Church on a regular basis.

As a Charity and a local Church we have been supporting various mission organisations over a number of years and continue to do so, they are Platform 67, Emmanuel Press and Claire Kinhead an AoG missionary in Jamaica. We have also been able to send humanitarian aid to victims of the war in the Ukraine via contacts our pastor had in Hungary. This year we have also started to support an organization that is local to our area, The Christian Institute, Newcastle, but has an input with Christian organizations throughout the United Kingdom.

The year covering the period of April 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 through to March 31<sup>st</sup> 2021 was a challenging time for Emmanuel Pentecostal Church as it was for the whole of the United Kingdom owing to the ongoing Covid 19 Pandemic

Our new pastor had arrived and been inducted in February 2020 and almost immediately into the new year in which this report covers the country entered a lockdown, this influenced what we could and could not do as a Church.

Because we were not able to gather, our pastor had already begun towards the end of the previous year 2019 -2020 sending out a daily devotion to all who wished to receive it, as a means of providing spiritual and emotional support and this was continued and continues through this accounting year and regular phone calls were made among the members to ensure that all were well and able to cope with this unprecedented situation.

Once it became obvious that the initial lockdown was going to last longer than it was first thought it would, a weekly video service was produced, and a link given to all members to be able to access and watch.

After the first lockdown was lifted, we began to meet again on a Sunday morning, following all the guidelines to ensure that the building was Covid safe and ensuring strict guidelines for safe gathering were followed. We regularly had the building cleaned by a professional company. This pattern was repeated following each of the shorter lockdowns that were imposed on the nation.

As a Church our mission has continued to provide support and aid to those in need in the community and in particular with contributions to a local Food bank in Gateshead.


