Activities and Achievements

Charity's activities and Achievements during the year in relation to its objects

The financial accounts for 2024 - 2025 balanced and have been verified. A profit of £10,260.85 was made.

We were Ofsted inspected in July 2021 and the outcome was Good. we are still waiting to be inspected in 2025/2026. Inspections have been delayed because of the changes to the curriculum and Ofsted reviewing their inspection reporting processes.

Our numbers remain high, with 1% of our families coming from the military families at Larkhill. It is still very positive for the following year. Our increased provision including a Monday afternoon session and a Wednesday morning and afternoon session are proving popular. September 25 will see the 2-year working parent entitlement increase to 30 hours. 99% of our children are now government funded under the National Education Grant, Working Parent Funding and Vulnerable Parent Funding schemes.

This year saw some changes to committee members. The committee didn't raise any money for the preschool through fundraising, and £465.00 was raised by preschool staff.
