The trustees present their annual report and the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 July 2019. The accounts comply with the current statutory requirements and with the requirements of the SORP.

**Constitution**

The charity was constituted on 1 February 1996 and is governed by a definitive Trust Deed and rules dated 16 February 1996 as amended on 7 January 1999 and 6 January 2000.

The trust is registered as a Charity, under number 1058443

**Objectives**

The purpose of the charity is to establish or secure the establishment of a community centre for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish of Great Notley, and to promote other charitable purposes as required.

**Activities**

The Association has continued to expand its membership during the year.  
The Data Protection policy was updated during the year.

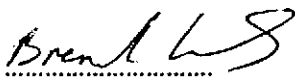
**Results**

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Under the Charities Act 1993, the Trustees are required to:

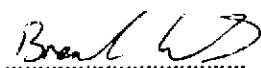
