These amounts fluctuate year on year depending on the number of children we have who also use another childcare setting. Our hourly rate is lower than the funded rate so it is expected that our income will be lower in the years where we can claim fewer hours' funding.</p> <p>The increase in NLW/NMW has, again, had an increase on wages for the year but our income levels are still such that we have been able to absorb the cost.</p> <p>Reserves remained healthy throughout the year and we are still operating mostly to capacity in all sessions.</p>




