I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 31st December 2024.



- State whether particular matters have come to my attention.
- My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as Trustees concerning any such matters. 


