The objects of the trust are for the trustees to hold the capital and income of the trust fund upon trust and to apply the income and any part of the capital at such time and in such manner to or for the benefit of such exclusively charitable objects and purposes in any part of the world as the trustees may in their absolute discretion determine. For the first 21 years of the trust's life the income may be accumulated at the trustees' discretion, the accumulation period ending on 17th June 2017.

On 17th June 1996 the settlor, Richard Walwyn Chapman, gifted 50,000 Ordinary Shares of 10p each in Cattles PLC into the trust. At that date the shares had a market value of £123,000. On 11 December 1996 the settlor gifted a further £500 in cash. In January 1997 the bulk of the holding in Cattles shares was sold and the proceeds invested in a diversified portfolio of quoted stocks and shares. The portfolio is subject to periodic review, at least half yearly, with a view to maintaining a balanced return between income and capital growth. A comprehensive schedule of investments showing cost, market value and income deriving therefrom is included within the notes.

The settlor Richard Walwyn Chapman died on 10th January 2005. Under the terms of his will he left the residue of his estate, after payment of general and specific legacies, to this charitable trust to be held by the trustees upon the terms of the trust. The following assets were transferred to the trust from the estate of R.W. Chapman (deceased).
