The attached financial statements show the current state of the finances which the trustees consider to be satisfactory. Cash balances brought forward at 6 April 2020 were £4,785. The income of the trust in the year was £124,300 and a total of £117,383 was paid out in grants and costs, leaving cash balances of £11,702 to carry forward.
