**ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE**

**Charitable activities**

**Introduction:**

During the full year David and Lindsay Griffiths, Brian Mason, Haroon B Masih, Suresh S Ramachandran, Ravinder Singh and Barry E Trayhorn were trustees. Towards the end of the year, we were joined by Pamela Masih.

The objective of this summary report is to show the activity that has taken place in view of meeting the Charity's ultimate objective of "reaching every creature" with the Gospel by "perfecting the saints" for the work of the ministry.

Introduction: The year was triumphant as regards the major steps being taken in view of meeting the objective, the year itself showing profit for the Charity, needed if we are to fulfil our aims. This comes after many years of threats and persecutions as we have fully supported and upheld the Constitutional Acts of the Country.

Trustees on many occasions have fought any attempt to change these constitutional demands seeing those who oppose the acts, as hitting against the very heart and foundations of our nation. Evidence of clear beginnings of totalitarianism in Britain and America were very apparent in this financial year.

**Part 1: The Intercessions:**

From the 1920's onwards our spiritual founder Rees Howells (whose College we have now restored) emphasized the importance of intercession. Indeed, it is our firm conviction that it is because of the intercession that went on in the College during the years of the Second World War, that conditions were made for a nation to not only continue its freedom but hold onto its Christian heritage and be able to take the Gospel to "every creature".

We exist today with the same passion, the ministry having travelled to specific locations, for specific purposes to maintain the puritan heritage of our nation, a heritage that gives the necessary freedom and resources to fulfil the call of God on all true Christians.

The number of travelling intercessions have been reduced this year, due to the recovering situation of Brian Mason, who had returned from trying to get into South Sudan very much incapacitated, and also towards the end of the financial year, the lockdown!

**Part 3: The Prophecies:**

The ministry has thrived through taking seriously the Word God has given us through prophecy now over decades. **Part 4: The Bible College & The Bible College Lecture Channel:**

In 1997 God gave clear instruction to have in our Declaration of Trust provision for a College. This we did and under the guidance of the Holy Ghost God led our ministry to join together with Brian Mason who had trained under Samuel Rees Howells. This College is free from the governmental system of textual criticism, instead choosing to have its ethos in the place where the College was spiritually born, in South West Scotland.

Here the Covenanters pledged their lives against the religious system, and where Rees Howells made his opening declaration on seeing their Solemn League and Covenant written in blood. The Covenanters had upheld the Royal Priesthood of Believers and the Protestant line of scripture whereas those who had taken over the College buildings at Swansea had chosen the Romanist route of the codices of Vaticanus, Sinaiticus and Alexandrinus, codices that hold the doctrines of the Roman Catholicism that deny the Trinity and the resurrection as it applies to believers, doctrines both Rees Howells and the Covenanters were passionate about.

The College therefore moved to the Cradle of Christianity in Scotland offering courses of sound doctrine taking on the establishment order as it has done with the Romanist infiltration of the Evangelical Pentecostal Movements as well as challenging the establishment order of the national churches in both England and Scotland.

We continue as with the intercessions at Cardoness House with the founding declaration of our College being on behalf of our nation whose Constitution is exactly in line with the bold declaration of Rees Howells:

The Spirit of God came on me to fight that Church: it was God's anger in me towards the Church of Rome, keeping those five hundred million souls in darkness on the Continent and elsewhere. I entered into a world where fellowship with people was not to count, the only fellowship was with those martyrs who had laid down their lives for the liberty of the Gospel. When I saw that Deed, (of the Covenanters) the Strength of God came into me and changed my body from clay to steel!" DIRECT QUOTE FROM REES HOWELLS

God was restoring the Bible College of Wales my dad knew as a student in the 1930's. They say to us today that you cannot go back but the Bible says:

Proverbs 22:28 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV) 28 - Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers have set.

The whole ethos of the Bible College of Wales came about during the early years, one of going through great pains and sufferings to be glorified together in a glorious result that only the Lord can take the glory.

This is so far away from the counterfeit that has been set up in Swansea of the charismatic movement. This is a surrender level so great and that we have kept to the Antioch line of scripture is so remarkable and so important and this relates into the courses we offer. With the following scripture ringing in our ears, the hard work in setting up courses, mark schemes etc. in line with true scripture is taking place knowing that the University system of sand inevitably will fall, and only that which has held to the true Word will stand. We have always known that it is right therefore never to affiliate with the system of the Deep State, but to be separate, be holy and honouring unto God.

Subjects studied under Evangelical Theology are The Atonement, Repentance, Baptism in Water, Baptism in the Holy Ghost, How to Receive the Baptism in The Holy Ghost, The Holy Ghost, The New Covenant Supper, Deep and Abiding Fellowship, God's Word, Praise, Worship, Prayer, God's Provision for Healing, Freedom from Bondage, The Sermon on the Mount - the Christian Walk, Trusting and Obeying, Commitment to the Body, God's Government and Order for the Church, Biblical Doctrine of Prosperity and Giving - not selfish lust, The New Covenant and Sound Economics, The Every Creature Commission, The Second Coming of Christ Jesus and Eternal Judgment, The Church, The Lead Up to the Rider on the White Horse, Great Faith, Growing in Faith and Being a Doer of the Word, The Rhema of God and Bold Confession in HIS NAME!

This course gives a Biblical Base in preparation for our other studies that includes **The Anointing Course**. The study deals with The Anointing on Jesus, The Anointing Within, Personal Leading of the Holy Ghost, Standing On the Word, The Anointing of the Five Fold Ministry Gifts, The Preaching Anointing, The Teaching Anointing, The Pastoring Anointing, The Prophet's Anointing, The Apostolic Anointing, How to Increase the Anointing, Yielding to the Anointing, Peculiar Anointings, The Healing and Corporate Anointings.

Having had experience of facing up to witchcraft both in Asia and UK during meetings the personal relationship of the Abba Father is so important not only in bringing LIFE to a congregation but also as regards protection to one's own life. In the course "How To Be Led by the Spirit of God", Spirit Consciousness, the differential between Soul and Spirit, the Inward Witness, the Fleece and the Inner Witness are all covered. Moving by the inner witness empowered by the Holy Ghost is so important. I talk with so many who profess to be Christian who talk with the natural mind. It is not being Christian for this is enmity against God, Peter being referred to as "Satan" in Matthew 16 when using natural rationale.

**Romans 10:9-10 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)**

9 - that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

The course therefore through the Word brings the conditions for the believer to continuously hear from God, and acting according to the Word being given at that time. This is for the empty vessel, not the intellectually charged individual who simply wants God to bless his/her decisions.

**The Jesus the Healer Course** emphasizes THE HEALER rather than healing bringing the conditions through the Word for 100% manifestation of healing in given situations. Reasons why people do not move in their healing are given be it that Christ Jesus won the victory at Calvary. There are many reasons and we cover this intensely in the course, for healing was won at Calvary and the manifestation of this is to occur through the ministers of God perfected through the Word of God.

**The Other Jesus Course** shows the counterfeit which is all over the world at this time.

**1 John 2:18 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)**

18 - Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.

The course begins looking at the warnings of Isaiah and Paul bringing out the two distinct lines of scripture, one from Antioch and the other from Alexandria, Egypt that combined the gnosis together with spirituality. From here we have today's Alpha course and this is examined in the context of its Anglican and Romanist roots.

Within this context has come textual criticism and the Alexandrian Bibles that forever change at the whim of the Vatican and Bible Societies bringing confusion to once great movements.

The course deals with Taoism and its infiltration into Methodism and the new revivals of the Emerging Church, a movement that began at Fuller Seminary in the United States, taking over orthodox movements all over the World, including the Pentecostal denominations, and even the original Bible College of Wales.

Then in the final lecture comes the glorious conclusion, a realisation of who the real Jesus is, this realisation being the final intercession of Norman Grubb who wrote Rees Howells Intercessor.

Further courses still awaiting video lecture conclusion include The Prayer and Intercession Course covering the key to answered prayer, the prayer that unlocks heaven, the authority of Jesus' Name, the prayer of agreement, factors to know about prayer, interpreting, tongues, heavenly places prayer, prayers of petition and consecration, prayers of worship, united prayer, prayers of commitment, what Jesus, Paul and others said about prayer, the will of God in prayer, why pray, the prayer of intercession, man's need for an intercessor, Jesus our intercessor, the Holy Ghost - our helper in intercession, the Holy Ghost - groanings and travail, the Holy Ghost and our infirmities, interceding against the infirmity of sickness, the intercession of the believer, ingredients for successful intercession, God's love, identification intercession, interceding for the lost, till Christ be formed in you, praying in the Spirit, quiet intercession, loud intercession, boldness, fervency, desire, perseverance, Intercession against sin, intercession in relation to deliverance, the intercession of the Body, intercession against the powers of darkness, fasting, intercession for the nation, revival and intercession, falling under the power and trance like states.

In preparation also was a very important course in relation to the future of the nation that constitutionally had let in foreign laws binding charities, NGO's and business to a global Deep State Agenda that was highly illegal.

**Teaching of our own Constitution** has not been taught in the schools, colleges or universities for years so God has ordained the Bible College of Wales to bring the Elizabethan Acts to the fore, thus in our view the many legal actions against us, but the TRUTH will never be defeated. The course is to deal with the following: The Act of Supremacy, The Elizabethan Settlement & The Coronation Oath, the theological significances of the Coronation Service, the EU Treaties that bound our country and the reasons why Roman Catholics cannot be part of the Royal Family as a Protestant cannot be the Pope - The 1700 Act of Settlement, the 1975 Referendum and the mandate it gave in comparison to the original blueprint of the EU, the corruptions that have bound our country and the rise in cultural Marxism, higher criticism in the "churches" with targeting against those of the old paths, the role of the big banks, the Bible College of Wales and its history of intercession for the nation, its role in constitutional education not only in Britain but throughout the World, the Solemn League and Covenant in Scotland and the Church of Scotland Act that constituted the Elizabethan Settlement into Scotland, the Constitutional protection on the preacher both in the pulpit and on the streets, and the Hebridean solution.

With Classical Civilization, New Testament Greek and teaching on the origins of Roman Catholicism, Lindsay too has been lecturing through the year and preparing courses to such a high level, that this can be only of the Lord, the preparation for great times ahead has been well on the way so we can begin to say the restoration of the Bible College of Wales is on track, Lindsay being in process too of producing a New Testament Survey course.

During the year Lindsay Griffiths has developed a New Testament Survey Course, we looking forward in future years in gaining more residential students as well as expanding the online ministry.

#### **PENTECOSTAL HOLINESS CHURCH**

This ministry that had begun in Cheshire, then North Wales continued in Whithorn from 24th. February 2019 covering the following themes, and now in this financial year, as well as regular Sunday meetings now included specific intercessions speaking release over certain identified villages. In addition, speaking into the Pandemic, heart felt prayer given for health care workers and their safety. **At the beginning of the year, Church Bible Studies on Saturday and Sunday nights continued.**

The Church using primary evidence exposed the takeover of the Elim Movement, resulting in a phone call from South Wales saying how much we were right, in how Elim had been taken over with another agenda than that of its founder George Jeffreys.

**CONTROLS:** Regulating through issue of regular financial reports, checking and approving invoices by more than one trustee, Chartered accountancy.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: L**

**4) Complying with Borrowing Restrictions**

**RISK:** Risk of not being able to obtain funds or having to repay early particularly in view of Emerging Church takeovers.

**CONTROLS:** Trustees to regularly assess borrowing and ensure actions taken early to reduce risk. Challenge the legality of Emerging Church takeovers.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: M - suggest agenda item to trustees to reduce to L.**

**5) Loss of Cash through theft or dishonesty**

**RISK:** Loss to Charity

**CONTROLS:** Little cash held at Charity premises, fidelity insurance cover

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: L -if fidelity insurance cover we have**

**6) Adequate Budget Management**

**RISK:** of overspend particularly in view of lack of response to giving outside the circle of trustees and Council of Reference.

**CONTROLS:** Detailed budget approved annually at AGM with detailed reports regularly going to trustees for checking.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: M - suggest agenda item to trustees to reduce to L.**

**7) Compliance with Tax Regulations**

**RISK:** ignorance of rules

**CONTROLS:** Courses for trustees, regular checking by professional help.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: M - suggest agenda item to trustees to reduce to L**

**8) Decision Making**

**RISK:** Charity may face legal actions resulting in financial penalties

**CONTROLS:** A decision book be kept of everyday decisions to be checked by trustees

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: H - suggest agenda item to trustees to reduce to L particularly in view of large amount of government enquiries**

**9) Contracts**

**RISK:** Risk of legal challenge due to non-compliance with terms of contract.

**CONTROLS:** Have a trustee read contracts and present report at meetings, seek legal advice.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING: L - if controls in place.**

**10) DOCUMENT CONTROL**

**RISK:** Risk of losing portable hard drives, manual documents etc.

**CONTROLS:** Re-do current manual files for all Charity archiving old material; back up of computer documents.

### **12) ABSENCE OF PROCEDURES SECRETARY/HI TECH OPERATOR**

**RISK:** With understaffing in the Charity there is a risk of non-operation should specialist staff be unavailable for long periods.

**CONTROLS:** We need to get more staff and train them in the operations of the Charity. At present staff are doing more than one job and over stretched.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** H - this issue needs to be addressed.

### **13) COMPLAINTS HANDLING**

**RISK:** Risk of action against the Charity, possibly resulting in drain of financial resources.

**CONTROLS:** That trustees bring together a COMPLAINTS POLICY AND PROCEDURE adopted in agreement with all trustees.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** H - with a designated group determined to destroy the charity through legal complaints - intercession, determination and conviction to overcome then down to L with the new complaints procedure.

### **14) ACCESS TO OFFICE FILES**

**RISK:** Access of Charity information to hostile infiltration.

**CONTROLS:** Regular security procedures.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** H - this issue needs to be addressed.

**CONTROLS:** Proper advice sought, Disciplinary and Grievance procedures, job descriptions, staffing meetings.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** L - If controls in place

### **16) COMPLYING WITH INLAND REVENUE REQUIREMENTS (Trading CO)**

**RISK:** Possibility of tribunals and financial penalties

**CONTROLS:** Regular updates, advice received from IR, checks by Chartered Accountant

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** M - if controls in place - Trading Company has had £100 fine due to late registration of figures even though figures in quickly.

### **17) Honesty/Integrity**

**RISK:** Possibility that Charity may be brought into disrepute and undergoing of time consuming investigations by the Charity Commission.

**CONTROLS:** Code of conduct agreed, accurate accounting practices and monitoring of operations.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** M - if controls in place - also strategy getting over the targeting of RC groups determined to destroy the charity through legalism.

### **18) Health and Safety of Staff & Visitors**

**RISK:** Risk of accident, injury or loss.

**CONTROLS:** Employers Liability insurance to cover volunteers, health and safety risk assessments; fire safety assessment.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** L - If controls in place

### **19) Lone Working**

**RISK:** Additional risk to volunteers, hirers, contractors due to lone working.

**CONTROLS:** Safe access and exit points; restricted access re. acts of violence; safety of equipment; emergency channels of communication; site security; alarm systems and personal attack alarms; supervision checking.

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** M - see ways to reduce to L

### **20) Public Events**

**RISK:**

**CONTROLS:** Adequate planning of events undertaken and roles and responsibilities identified; insurance checked

**SUGGESTED RISK RATING:** L



As the charity trustees of the Trust you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').





**1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Basis of preparing the financial statements**

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

**Financial reporting standard 102 - reduced disclosure exemptions**

The charity has taken advantage of the following disclosure exemptions in preparing these financial statements, as permitted by FRS 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland':

- the requirements of Section 7 Statement of Cash Flows;
- the requirement of paragraph 3.17(d);
- the requirements of paragraphs 11.42, 11.44, 11.45, 11.47, 11.48(a)(iii), 11.48(a)(iv), 11.48(b) and 11.48(c);
- the requirement of paragraph 33.7.

**Income**

All income is recognised once the charity has entitlement to the income, it is probable that the income received and the amount of income receivable can be measured reliably.

For legacies, entitlement is taken as the earlier of the date on which either: the charity is aware that probate has been granted, the estate has been finalised and notification has been made by the executor(s) to the Trust, that a distribution will be made, or when a distribution is received from the estate. Receipt of a legacy, in whole or in part, is only considered probable when the amount can be measured reliably and the charity has been notified of the executor's intention to make a distribution. Where legacies have been notified to the charity, or the charity is aware of the granting of probate, and the criteria for income recognition has not been met, the legacy is treated as a contingent asset and disclosed if material.

Income tax recoverable in relation to donations received under Gift Aid or deeds of covenant is recognised at the time of the donation.

**Expenditure**

Expenditure is recognised once there is a legal or constructive obligation to transfer economic benefit to a third party, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefit will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is classified by activity. The cost of each activity are made up of the total of direct costs and shared costs, including support costs involved in undertaking each activity. Direct costs attributable to a single activity are allocated directly to that activity. Shared costs which contribute to more than one activity and support costs that are not attributable to a single activity, are apportioned between those activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources. Central staff costs are allocated on the basis of time spent and depreciation charges are allocated to the portion of the asset's use.

Governance costs are those incurred in connection with administration of the charity and compliance with constitutional and statutory requirements.

Charitable activities and Governance costs are costs incurred on the charity's educational operations, including support costs and costs relating to the governance of the charity apportioned to charitable activities.

**Tangible fixed assets**

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

**Taxation**

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

**Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

**Interest receivable**

Interest on funds held on deposit is included when receivable and the amount can be measured reliably by the charity; this is normally upon notification of the interest paid or payable by the bank.

**Cash at bank and in hand**

Cash at bank and in hand includes cash and short term highly liquid investments with a short term maturity of three months or less, from the date of acquisition or opening of the deposit or similar account.

**Debtors**

Trade and other debtors are recognised at the settlement amount after any trade discount offered. prepayments are valued at the amount incurred, net of any trade discounts due.

**Liabilities & provisions**

Liabilities are recognised when there is an obligation at the Balance Sheet date as a result of a past event, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefit will be required in settlement, and the amount of the settlement can be estimated reliably. Liabilities are recognised at the amount that the charity anticipates it will pay to settle the debt or the amount it has received as advance payments for the goods and services it must provide. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation. Where the effect of the time value of money is material, the provision is based on the present value of those amounts, discounted at the pre-tax discount rate that reflects the risks specific to the liability. The unwinding of the discount is recognised within interest payable and similar charges.

**Financial instruments**

The charity only has financial assets and financial liabilities of a kind that qualify as basic financial instruments. Basic financial instruments are initially recognised at transaction value and subsequently measured at their settlement value, with the exception of bank loans which are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.
