ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING - CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2023

I am pleased to present on behalf of the trustees our twenty sixth report following our registration as a Registered Charity.

Accounts

We can again report that the Band's finances remain in credit. We have received a donation of £107k from the estate of the late Mr John Walter, who sadly passed away. Mr Walter was a supporter of the Band attending numerous concerts and events over the years.

Fund Raising Activities

With the players that we have we were able to play carols over the Christmas period and at a couple of events during the year.

The impact from the Covid pandemic has continued; with membership being a challenge.

We have tried various recruitment drives during the year. We have agreed to support our local community school by supplying brass instruments so that the music teachers can teach brass playing in the school. The overall aim being to encourage young people to learn to play brass instruments and hence to rebuild the Band.

Band Hall

The existing hall lease continues to be renewed annually by Cornwall Council. As previously reported Cornwall Council has confirmed that our plans will remain valid as long as we do not materially amend the build design, since the completed infrastructure was on our plans. Various communications via email occurred during the year confirming that Cornwall Council will still honour the £50,000 commitment to us towards building our New Band Hall. Revised Heads of Terms of the contract are still in progress, which as agreed previously transfer the freehold to the Band.

Expenditure

The Band has continued to limit their requests to essential expenditure in order to save funds for the new hall and recruitment drives. We have had to carry out essential repairs to the existing hall flat roof.

Committee

Sadly one of our trustees has been diagnosed with cancer so he has had to stop playing.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Committee for their contributions and commitment throughout the year and look forward to their help and input for the coming year.

My thanks to all those members continuing to participate in an active role for the continuance of Bude Town Band.
