Report of the Trustees on the Activities of the Charity

The Trustees present the Independently Examined Income and Expenditure Account of the Charity in accordance with the adopted accounting policy, for the year ended 31st August 2023.

The majority of the income was received via Gift of Opportunity, funds raised by the school and Just Giving donations.

The closing balance of the fund is £244,863.65.

It is felt that the Burford School Fund has met the Public benefit need by operating within its objectives.

- Safeguarding the Charity's assets and hence taking reasonable steps for prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
