**Report:-**

DC welcomed all to the trustees meeting and explained that the purpose of the meeting was to inform the trustees of the groups finances and how we have tried to mitigate the financial impact on the group.

DC informed the meeting that the group had experienced some serious financial problems during the pandemic as little to no income had been received. Due to this position an approach was made to Leicestershire County Council Shires Grant programme for a covid recovery grant. This thankfully was approved and resulted in the group receiving a grant of £11,880.00 on the 15 April 2021.

We were approached again by the Leicestershire County Council Shires Grant programme and encouraged to apply for a further grant, which we did and were yet again successful in our grant application. This additional grant was for a further £5,000.00 on 14 December 2021.

The above grants have been invaluable to the group and has enabled us to survive during this very difficult period.
