I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2022

RESPECTIVE Responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year (under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011(the Charities Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

Basis of independent examiners report

It also includes consideration of unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters.
