The Rector and Churchwardens are trustees according to the constitution; the remainder of Officers and Trustees stand for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.

In 2024 sales were below 2023 levels by 8% however the shop still achieved over £1,000 a week.

Trading profits were also lower at £31.1k which included a spend of £8.3k from JMR property maintenance, painting and repairing the property, to ensure we are adhering to the conditions of our lease.

In 2024 we continued to support local projects, and individuals. Grants to Holy Trinity church were considerable in 2024 having made no contribution in 2023. This amounted to £20.8k and was used to repair the roof, install a new screen, replace 2 ageing laptops and support the new Children & Families Leader.

Hurst Festival remains an important recipient £5k, our focus being to support events within the festival which are free to all, including Super Sunday, a village event for everyone.

This year we have sent a grant £5k towards the renovation of a bathroom in the Almshouses of the Holy name in Brighton Road. We have also supported St Barts in Albourne to repair a dangerous electrical system in the church.

The new Hurst Folk festival in November which started in 2023 is also supported to the tune of £1.5k

We have contributed £1.5k towards a community project called Grow it & Cook it undertaken by Albourne C of E school.

The Befriended grant of £1.0k towards a series of social events in the summer called “Holiday at home” which includes a theatre trip to Chichester.

St Lawrence fair was again given a grant of £1.0k to help with the costs of the fair.

We supported Santa Sunday with a grant of £0.75k and Melting pot café with the provision of a number of indoor games We also paid a grant to the Sanctuary for new reusable cups £0.5k.

There were also a number of smaller grants which are listed in the accounts.

The trustees would like to thank all our volunteers for their continued support and dedication which without which none of this would be possible.





The Rector and Churchwardens are trustees according to the constitution, the remainder of Trustees stand for re-election at the Annual General meeting.

2022 was a return to pre-covid trading £54k averaging over £1,040 per week. This was an excellent result as we have reduced our hours, 9am – 1pm 6 days a week. During the year we introduced a bank card machine, this has become increasingly popular and now accounts for around 60% of our trading.

In 2022 as in previous years we continue to support several local projects and individuals. Hurst Festival remains an important benefactor £4k, our focus has been to support events within the festival which are free to all, including Super Sunday a village event for everyone. We supported, The Platinum jubilee, Hurst Rethink which supports village eco projects & Whatson in Hurst, all of whom received small grants.

We continued to support the Christmas traders evening with a grant towards the costs of running the event, with added organisational support from the shop.

We have also supported 18 Ukrainian families with small grants of £200 per family to help with their initial costs. This was supplemented by vouchers for 10 free items from the shop as a goodwill gesture.

We continue to support Holy Trinity with a grant of £15k as a contribution towards the new audio-visual system. In addition, we have covered the cost of the church clock repairs.

The trustees would like to sincerely thank all our volunteers for their continued support and dedication without which none of these projects would be possible.





2021 was a return to better trading with sales increasing to £26.4k, from 2020 sales of £14.0k. Trading is not yet back to pre-covid levels which were at around £45.0k

In 2021 we have supported a number of local projects and individuals including Hurst Festival, St Lawrence school, Hurst Hedgehog Haven & a young local gymnast. We also helped support the Christmas traders evening with a grant to the Traders association.

Local charities include, Fairfield Mother & Toddler Group, Hurst District Childminders & Hurst Community charity group. We also donated to The Monday Group who continue to replace and renovate stiles, and walk ways around the Parish.

Holy Trinity remains a benefactor, with significant contributions to the reordering project. The contributions in 2021 were an accumulation of a number of year's profits which had not been taken until 2021. The new projector, screen and sound desk in the church has made a significant impact on the workings of the church. The new systems coupled with new flexible seating has enabled the church to enter the 21st century, an enable weddings, funerals and concerts to be "live" streamed, particularly useful when relatives live abroad.

The trustees would like to sincerely thank all our volunteers for their continuing support and dedication without which none these projects would be possible.






