INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF

Independent examiner's report to the trustees of West Lavington Youth Club ('the Charity'), registered charity number 1080380

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of the Charity for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025. Responsibilities and basis of report
