In the year under review most activities have been maintained and it is intended to continue the activities supporting the families and to expand the scope of the help that is given to them as funds become available.


Financial review

The Accounting Statement shows a deficit of receipts over payments of £82 (2024: surplus £625).

The funding of the charity's activities and the expenditure on them during the year is shown in the Accounting Statement. No reserves are held other than day to day cash funds and the charity will continue to receive funding as required by way of grants from The Robert Mayhew Charitable Trust in London. During the year short term interest free loans were received in Chile from related parties and these are repaid out of funds received from London as available.
