The trustees present their annual report and financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2025.

Reference and Administrative Details

Crown of Glory Church is a charitable organisation established for religious and charitable purposes. The charity operates in accordance with its governing document, which defines its objectives and governance arrangements. The trustees are responsible for the overall control, management, and strategic direction of the charity.

Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is administered by a board of trustees appointed in line with the governing document. The trustees meet regularly and are responsible for ensuring good governance, safeguarding, financial oversight, and compliance with charity law. 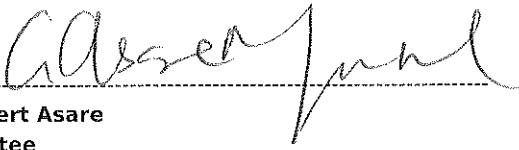
Plans for the Future

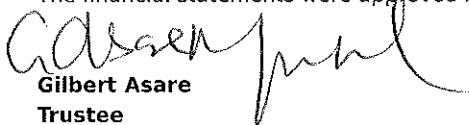

1. Accounting Policies

The principal accounting policies adopted by the Charity, which is a public benefit entity, in the preparation of the accounts are as follows.

1.1 Basis of preparation

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention, as modified by the inclusion of charitable properties and fixed asset investments and investment properties at valuation.

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102)" (effective 1 January 2019) - (Charities SORP (FRS 102)), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) and the Charities Act 2011.

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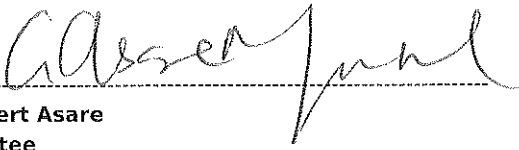

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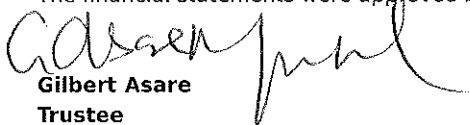
