We open the Gurdwara every Sunday for worship as well as open on specific religious events such as Guru Ravidas Ji's birthday, Diwali etc. As well as this we hold religious weddings based upon our Holy Book and birthday celebrations for members who wish to share their day with Guru Ji and the congregation.

The Gurdwara is also designed to attract a greater congregation who follow the teachings of our Guru.

As a charity we do not have any source of income and all money is generated from donations from the congregation and collections done by the committee members.






