Structure, Governance and Management

Shawbury United Junior Football Club is governed by its constitution adopted on 20 May 1998 as amended on 6 December 2000, and is classified as an association.

Trustees

The Trustees are made up of volunteers from the committee, parents, managers and assistants. The Trustees that served during the year are detailed in the General Information on Page 1 of these accounts.

Objectives

The objectives of the charity is to advance the education of children between the ages of 5 and 18 years residing in Shropshire by providing facilities and opportunities for playing football so as to promote and encourage their physical development.

Activities

In planning our activities for the year, we kept in mind the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

The focus of our activities remains the participation in the local football league and local cup competitions. We welcome all young people regardless of personal background, faith, gender or personal circumstances and we believe this philosophy of openness to all enriches everyone through the sharing of skills, aptitude and life experiences of our young people and volunteers.

Achievements and Performance

The Club had twelve teams plus the creche during the season and a membership of over 190 boys and girls and within this number, we welcomed two new teams this year, the U16's and U18's who both competed in the Midland Junior Premier League. All teams performed well during the season.

Financial review

With the main source of income being generated from membership subscriptions, the Income and Expenditure Account details a net deficit for the year of £2,009 and reserves at 31 July 2020 totalling £51,123.

The deficit for the year has been mainly incurred due to the costs of professional fees in relation to planning applications, surveys and legal fees in relation to the lease of the land donated for the new ground in Shawbury. These costs will be recovered as funding streams are secured for the development of the new ground and facilities.

The prepayment of registration fees is allocated against the year to which they apply and this figure together with any Gift Aid received after the financial year end makes up the amount within sundry debtors and prepayments. Any income received in advance is shown as an amount carrying forward within accruals.

Reserves Policy

Reserves are being accumulated to help fund the development of the new ground and facilities in Shawbury and negotiations are currently taking place with the land owner with regard to the lease of the land that has been donated to the Club. Further funding sources are also being identified and secured to meet the development costs of the new ground and facilities.
