A report was submitted and acknowledged by the Charities Commission. This crime was reported to the Police but the case was not taken forward by the CPS as the money was since repaid in this financial year. As such many of our controls were tightened. However, it is acknowledged that the trustees are in a position of power and so theft has been acknowledged as a risk to the charity although with the controls in place this should be mitigated.

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
