The trustees present their annual report and accounts of the charity for the year ended 31/03/2022.

CONSTITUTION

The charity was established by dated 15 October 2001 and was subsequently registered with Charity Commission (Registered Charity Number 1091454). The Charity is managed by the trustees.

AIMS & OBJECTS

The charity is constituted for the promotion of the religion and cultural traditions of the Hindu Religion.

ACTIVITIES

This Hindu religious charity organisation aims to honour the true picture of Vedic religion and literature for the welfare of the local community and humanity as a whole. The following services are being provided presently:

1. A Hindu priest (M.A. in Sanskrit, the holy language of Hindu religion).
2. All religious ceremonies from birth to death.
3. A place of worship for our Hindu community.

4. Advice sessions by qualified religious preachers (qualified in Vedic scriptures) , selected by Vedic priest to encompass the enriched communion of peoples.

5. To provide Ayurvedic services on a non - religious in terms of Yoga/Yogic food,healing remedies and meditation.

5. We do Live Show on the Hindu religion, Scriptures, Vedic Astrology and remedies on the Sky Channel 711 MATV on every Sunday between 3pm to 5pm and broadcast throughout the world via social media and programme is very popular.

Religious and non-religious services are provided to encourage all members of the community to use the services on a drop in basis for holistic and spritual reasons as well as religious for the unity of people. The local people have been free to access the centre on a daily basis and encouraged to feel free to debate and discuss all issues mentioned. So far, an affluent mix of nationalities and cultures has offered time and opinion on various subjects.

We anticipate raising funds:-

(a) From all Hindu religious services i.e. birth ceremony, name giving ceremony, new house entry, marriage,havan/prayers at people's home, all rituals, funerals, astrology, palmistry services etc.

(b) by excepting donations, providing remedies and organizing festivals.



REPORT OF TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH 2021.

The trustees present their annual report and accounts of the charity for the year ended 31/03/2021.

CONSTITUTION

The charity was established by dated 15 October 2001 and was subsequently registered with Charity Commission (Registered Charity Number 1091454). The Charity is managed by the trustees.

AIMS & OBJECTS

The charity is constituted for the promotion of the religion and cultural traditions of the Hindu Religion.

ACTIVITIES

This Hindu religious charity organisation aims to honour the true picture of Vedic religion and literature for the welfare of the local community and humanity as a whole. The following services are being provided presently:

1. A Hindu priest (M.A. in Sanskrit, the holy language of Hindu religion).
2. All religious ceremonies from birth to death.
