

  - which will be used in our promotional and fund-raising activities in UK
7. "Management and administration" includes costs incurred in the day to day management of the charity, primarily bank charges in UK and for grants paid to bank accounts in Uganda.
8. "Other payments" includes any non-recurring minor items not included in the above categories.
