- The charity was able to send £53,972 (\$70,600 USD) to Orran, a children's charity in Armenia. In addition to these payments,
 - a further payment of £23,871 was made to other charities (World Vision, Oxfam etc). Total payments made into the trust amounted to £64,921 of which £301 were from bank interest
- The trust holds £682 of unrestricted funds at year end.

~~There are currently~~ plans in the next tax year to fund the yearly payment of up to \$50,000 to Orran towards the operating costs of the two centers, namely Yerevan and Vanadzor.

The Trustees plan to visit Armenia at their own expense to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the formation of Orran, which is the main beneficiary of the Krikorian Charitable Trust receiving 83% of the trust income. In addition the trust will continue to support fundraising efforts focused in Los Angeles with the annual fund raising gala towards the end of each year
