INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF MUSLIM SOCIETY OF PRESTON NEW ROAD

We report on the accounts for the year ended 5th April 2021 set out on the following pages.

Repective responsibilities of trustees and examiner
