## TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PERIOD 01.09.2024-31.08.2025

1. Independent examiner's report generated on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2026 and no recommendations made.
2. The School Fund supported the purchase of many items and services throughout the year including music systems for the two playgrounds, National Trust membership, electric pencil sharpeners for every class, and security improvements for the school minibus.
3. A donation of £5000 was made towards the whole school IT upgrade with a further donation of another £5000 planned for the academic year 2025/2026.
4. The annual Food Fayre was another great success and was able to support a full refurbishment of both the Food Technology Room and the Art Room.
5. Children in Years 3-6 were all able to attend a residential trip of at least one night if they chose to and a discount of 25% for those eligible for Pupil Premium was offered again.
6. PALMS once again donated £200 to each year group towards their chosen educational day trips. The annual Christmas and Summer Fairs, discos and cookie days were as popular as ever and raised funds to support a variety of school events.
7. The School Council funded various projects including a mural in the library, a set of go-karts for breaktimes and a new stage for awards assemblies with the proceeds of their dress up days.
8. Money was raised for Jeans for Genes, Comic Relief, MIND and Children in Need this year.
9. Sharon Spencer, Independent Examiner from The Bursary, appointed for the 2025/26 academic year.
