3. Sheepfold Meetings

House Group Meetings named "Sheepfold" meetings were carried out on a weekly basis before lockdown, and were postponed during the lockdown period for health and safety of the members.

4. The Women's Ministry

The Women's Ministry held weekly prayer meetings every Saturday morning throughout the year before lockdown. With worship and praise and prayer and Bible Studies. During lockdown Online studies continued and weekly Friday evening prayer meetings were carried out on Zoom and Google Meet.

5. The Youth Ministry

The Youth Ministry met regularly on fortnightly occasions before lockdown and Covid restrictions, giving direction and encouragement to the youth from the Wigan area. During Lockdown the meetings were postponed, for health and safety purposes, but contact via telephone was kept with Youth Members.

6. Craft/Outreach Session

Craft/Outreach sessions have continued at the beginning of the year, and were postponed during the lockdown period for health and safety purposes. Crafts taught Included sewing, card making, jewellery making etc..

Financial Performance

During the year the charity received income amounting to £74,686 (2019 £73,826). Total expenditure for the year was £63,292 (2019 £68,557). Thus giving a profit for the year of £11,394 (2019 profit £5,269).

At 31 December 2020 net book value of property, plant and equipment comprising church building, office and church equipment was £91,061 (2019 £93,816). Current assets comprising cash balances at bank and in hand and debtors balances totalled £60,897 (2019 £46,954). Liabilities of the charity at year end amounted to £1674 (2019 £1,880). Thus total funds of the charity represented by total assets less liabilities was £150,284 (2019 £138,890).

Giving to Missions

Total giving to Missions during the financial year ending 31st December 2020 amounted to £4,830 (2019 £4,000) representing 6.5% (2019: 5.4%) of total income for the year.

Structure, governance and management

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Grace Fountain Church Limited is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 14 May, 2002 as Greenough Christian Fellowship and registered as a charity on 22 November, 2002. The name changed to Grace Fountain Church Limited on 20th November 2014. The company was established under a Memorandum of Association which established the objects and powers of the charitable company and is governed under its Articles of Association. In the event of the company being wound up members are required to contribute an amount of £1.

Appointment of Trustees

As set out in the Articles of Association new trustees are elected by members of the charitable company providing they qualify in accordance with any criteria or policy for admission of members made by the trustees.

The trustees when complete consist of at least 3 and not more than 7 individuals.

One third (or the number closest to the one third) of the trustees must retire after the first 3 years and then every 2 years thereafter, those longest in office retiring first. However, retiring trustees may be nominated for re-appointment

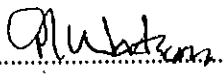

Independent examiner's report to the trustees of Grace Fountain Church Limited ('the Company')

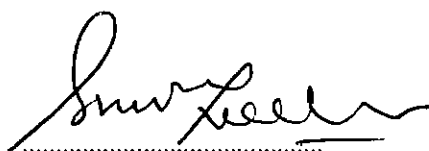
The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of its financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2020 in accordance with Section 476 of the Companies Act 2006.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2020

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Church Building	- 2% on cost
Fixtures and fittings	- 25% on cost

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The charitable company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the charitable company's pension scheme are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.
