## Summary

Our admittance figures are dramatically increased from last year particularly kitten numbers, but the kitten rehoming numbers are also in line with this. These increases are undoubtedly linked to the cost of living crisis with many cats coming in due to no fault evictions. The increase in kitten numbers is probably related to the high cost of veterinary charges meaning many people are unable to afford routine treatment and neutering. The number of stray/abandoned pregnant pet cats was much higher this year than in previous years.

## **Income.**

Our total income was higher this year with both the shop income and donations increased from last year. The higher rehoming numbers probably accounted for much of the increased donations. We also received a very generous legacy during the year.

## **Expenditure.**

With the exception of stationery all our costs were increased this year but most notably in veterinary charges and shop expenditure. The veterinary cost reflect the higher number of cats taken in and include the cost of our neutering assistance vouchers.

The increased shop expenses include a new conservatory added to the shop to increase floor space and improve security but also we have employed a part time Shop Co-ordinator to help with the running of the shop during the week.

## **Looking Forward.**

The financial crisis continues to have a negative effect on pet ownership, making it difficult for people to afford even routine veterinary costs. We are aiming to continue with our neutering vouchers and have increased the value from £50 to £65 for female cats. We also plan to target colonies of farm cats which are repeatedly adding to the numbers of stray/feral kittens being born; neutering usually improves the general health of the colony as well as the individual cats. During the summer we are often overwhelmed with the number of unwanted kittens and pregnant stray cats that we are asked to take in. It is counter productive to allow the cattery to become overcrowded as this often leads to the spread of virus's and parasites so to enable us to take in more cats without this risk we are hoping to recruit more foster carers, individuals who will take a litter of kittens or even just the odd one or two, into their home and care for them until a home can be found for them. We would cover all costs involved.

## Summary

Our admittance and rehoming figures are very similar to last years with both adult cats and kittens arriving in much the same numbers.

Our neutering figures have increased but this is due to our neutering assistance vouchers.

We have noticed that there has been much more demand on our Pet Food bank facility with many owners struggling at times to cover the food costs for their pets.

Also increasing veterinary costs are causing many owners problems. We are trying to assist with the cost of neutering through our ongoing voucher scheme but we have also been asked to make contributions towards the cost of treating illness or injury as owners face unexpected vets fees at a time when household budgets are low.

This may be the reason that we have noticed more cats being abandoned and in several cases these cats have had quite serious injuries which have been left untreated.

These injuries may have been sustained as the cats are trying to eke out a survival on their own or they may have been thrown out because of the unaffordable veterinary treatment needed. Many of these abandoned cats are un-neutered which of course creates another problem further on down the line as they produce a colony of stray, feral offspring.

**Income:** Our income has increased this year as although our donations are reduced from the previous year, our shop income has increased and we have also benefitted from two generous legacies.

**Expenditure:** With the exception of Stationery, which has reduced, all areas of spending have increased on last year. This is largely due to general price increases; our shop expenditure is particularly effected by the higher cost of electricity but also the cost of installing security camera's at the shop.

## Looking Forward.

Although our primary aim is to rescue and rehome we feel that it is important to try and support pet owners who are experiencing financial difficulties as this is often a short term issue and if we can prevent cats needing to be rehomed or from becoming strays it is better for everyone in the long term, So with this in mind we will continue our Neutering Assistance Vouchers and also our pet food bank facility as it is likely that the cost of living crisis will continue for some time.

## Summary

Our income has continue to rise this year as our shop has continued to be a great success and we have now let the flat above the shop and have regular income from the rent. Our veterinary fees this year have reduced as we have not had any large colony of cats requiring extensive veterinary treatment due to previous neglect as we did last year.

Our rehoming has dropped a little; this is probably due to the cost of living crisis which continues to affect many people. This unfortunately slows the system down a little and can affect our ability to take in other urgent cases. Our admittance figures are down from last year which means we means our neutering and microchipping figures have also decreased.

## Looking forward.

We are aware that colonies of cats exist and are helping people manage them by providing food and neutering so that they can be managed effectively. Hopefully our shop and rental income will put us in place to do as much as we can. We are looking to continue to assist cat owners with the cost of neutering their pets as an ongoing project as this is the only way to reduce the number of unwanted animals. There is as always so much work to do.



## Summary

Our income has increased dramatically this year as our shop has been a great success and we have had no more interruptions to our opening because of Covid restrictions. Our expenditure on the flat was a little higher than we anticipated but the work has now been completed and the extra income from the rent will be very welcome.

Our veterinary fees this year also increased dramatically and this is due to a large group of cats which we took in who all needed extensive veterinary treatment due to previous neglect.

Our rehoming has dropped a little is this is probably because many of the cats that we took in needed veterinary treatment and were recovering with us for some time before they could be rehomed. This unfortunately slows the system down a little and can affect our ability to take in other urgent cases. Although our admittance figures are slightly increased from last year.

Our neutering and microchipping figures have also increased this year.

## Looking forward.

It is becoming clear that there will be consequences from the clamour for pets during and post lockdown as people return to normal working practice. Also the increased cost of living which is likely to get worse before it gets better means that many of these pets will be discarded by families that can no longer afford them. Charities like ours will be severely stretched by the needs of these animals and I'm not sure that we will be able to help them all. It is therefore essential that we make every effort to build up the charities funds again so that we can afford to do everything possible to help.

Hopefully our shop and rental income will put us in place to do as much as we can. If possible we would like to assist pet owners with the cost of neutering their pets either in a short campaign or as an ongoing project as this is the only way to reduce the number of unwanted animals. There is as always so much work to do.



We neutered 38 cats and microchipped 44 cats through the year.

## Summary

Our income during this 12 month period was repeatedly affected by lockdowns and reduced customer confidence due to the Covid situation although we were fortunate to receive government grants which certainly helped.

Many of our costs were reduced because of the lower number of kittens admitted to the rescue cattery.

Our increased Misc. costs were due to the preparation of the new shop for opening.

Our rehoming remained steady throughout the year although the number of kittens coming into the rescue cattery was lower than usual probably because the demand for kittens was high and so fewer needed our help. The number of adult cats admitted during the year was higher because we took in several large groups from multi-cat households.

Our new shop has so far been very successful and we hope this will continue and that we can recruit more volunteers to increase our opening hours.

## Looking forward.

We hope to start work on the flat above the shop soon so that the rental income will increase our regular income. We also feel that it will be beneficial to have someone on the premises over night.

We are concerned that the high demand for kittens during the lockdowns over the last 18 months may lead to increased numbers of unwanted kittens in the future due to indiscriminate breeding in the belief that money can be made from selling them. We can only wait and see.


