NYPP AGM 21st April 2022

I am very pleased to welcome you all to the Newbald Young People's Project Annual General Meeting 2022.

As always, I would like to thank all the committee members for their hard work and dedication this year. Without you this building and the clubs held here would not exist. It is never easy relying on everyone's goodwill as we are all so busy, but as always you have all stepped up and gone above and beyond to keep this place not only running but also developing what we offer. The AGM is a nice time to sit back and think of all we have achieved over the last year. I think we sometimes forget that not many villages or towns have a place like The Rooms and we should all be proud of the space and opportunities we provide here.

I would also like to thank Richard Croston for preparing the accounts for the charity. Special thanks also go to our new volunteers – Paul Clucas, Dave Frampton, Dave Blamires, John Ramsell and Joanna Borecka. We cannot express how much we appreciate you giving up your time. Welcome to the team!

Many thanks too to our youth workers Tracey Beasty and Mandy Andrews – Mandy has been with us just over a year but already feels like she has always been here. And to Raveen and Laura who have taken on the Friday night sessions. We thank you all for their commitment in making the youth groups a welcoming and fun place for local young people to attend. Many thanks too go to Debbie, Lucy and Sophie who give up their Thursdays to run the Toddler group, it is lovely to see a toddler group in the village again as we all know what a lifeline this was when our children were younger.

Youth Groups

We have had some challenges in retaining number this year as not everyone has continued to attend after Covid restrictions ended, but we continue to increase our profile via social media and hope that as more people learn about our presence they will see what a great place this is and will want to be involved.

The Friday nights remain popular, and we have developed the facilities available to the older children to include a pool table, table football and basketball net.

Cookery Club has just restarted in a different format and was very well received. Hopefully this is just the beginning of starting to redevelop this

very popular session so that many more children can benefit from the facilities we have here.

It was only in September 2021 that we started Toddler Group – we now have three volunteers running the weekly sessions with a modest but regular group of mums and toddlers attending. We hope to promote this group during the village Gala when we will have a craft and activity tent aimed at the younger generation.

The Building

With the assistance of our new maintenance team we have finally managed to tick off some jobs on the DIY To Do list! After about 8 years the key box has finally been put up – just a shame that no one can remember the combination to it! Not to mention the erection of ‘the sign’ – at long last people know where we are. The Rooms is really looking at its best – which is fantastic as we will have the chance to show it off during the jubilee celebrations in June.

The repair of the back wall also took place this year and it has made a significant difference to how our outside area looks. The new lights outside have made it a much safer area for the Friday youth club group on a dark evening, and when we get the BBQ repaired and renovated we might even be able to manage a Summer BBQ evening for the older group.

Funding

As I look back over the year we have had some really successful events – the apple harvest this year was exceptional. I have never taken so many apples to be juiced – We extend our thanks to Adrian Hancock and the Richardson family for very kindly donating all the apples (and the Tuesday youth group and committee of course for picking them!)

The Christmas fair was held for the first time in the village hall and I think I can say for certain that we have established a reputation for holding a really high quality festive event.

Pop up pizza was again well received – this is the second time we have held this event and it is now firmly in the calendar as an annual occurrence.

This year will hopefully see a few more events as life starts to return for normal and it will be great to host events such as the wine tasting again.

The successful application for ERYC food hygiene rating means that we can restart Meal on Wheels – which I know will be well received by the older residents of the village.

I would also like to thank Richard Croston for preparing the accounts for the charity and also to Emma Hibbs for doing so brilliantly in securing extra funds through grant applications.

Particular thanks go to our youth workers; to Tracey Beasty - who frequently goes above and beyond in her commitment to the Rooms, and Georgina Tooke who is sadly leaving us this year and will be greatly missed by the committee and the children.

Youth Groups/Activities

It has been a difficult year with the cessation of all activities due to Covid from March 2020 onwards. Prior to lockdown the groups had retained their numbers but unfortunately we have only gained a few new members this year. Plans to develop a walking bus to increase numbers were put on hold due to Covid. During lockdown we offered the option of suspending the direct debit but very few families have decided to do this.

The committee also publicised the fact that we would run a meals-on-wheel style service from The Rooms to assist the local elderly and vulnerable. There was no take up on this scheme as it appeared that local people managed to cope well with the lockdown restrictions.

Prior to lockdown the youth group took part in harvesting apples (with a sell out on the apple juice!), the Big Soup Share, making items for the Christmas Fayre and manning the stalls, serving at the Toll Gavel fundraiser, and Pancake celebrations at the church.

Cookery Club also continued to be very popular with sessions booked months in advance. Florence Grimes very capably took over the role of assistant. One-off cookery sessions were also held to include the older members of the youth clubs/village. Plans to hold an afternoon tea and meals for the teachers had to be put on hold due to Covid but we hope to carry out these plans in 2021.

We are currently running a photography competition whilst the rooms are closed to develop a selection of picture of the local area that we will display in the Rooms.

The Building

There have been further improvements to the hall with the fantastic new cookers and funding is ready and waiting for the new roof and the new store room – hopefully to be completed before the middle of September. Once these works are completed we can look at repairing the damp wall and upgrading the sofas. We also have plans for a new sink area in the kitchen. Finally, the new access light at the entrance to the corridor has been installed which will create a safe walk way once the dark nights draw in.

Funding

Members of the committee have worked very hard and have been able to secure funding for the roof and the kitchen upgrades, along with an unexpected but very welcome grant from the East Riding Council during the Covid crisis. The Toll Gavel coffee mornings have become a regular event and we managed to hold two this calendar year.

The Christmas Fair broke the £1,000 mark for fundraising – a real testament to all the hard work and promotion and jiggling of buckets from the committee! The Apple Festival was quiet regarding attendance but the new system of having the juice externally bottle worked extremely well and we could have probably sold twice the amount we made! A new orchard has been sourced for this year.

Policies & Procedures

All policies and procedures have been reviewed and updated this year in order to be able to qualify for the SMILE Hive accreditation. We have also joined the East Riding Village Halls Network and they have been a source of lots of valuable information around reopening in line with Covid regulations. We hope that this annual membership will have many benefits.

Committee Members

Sally left this year and Emma has stepped up to take on the challenging role of Treasurer, with Clare also taking on the busy role of secretary in conjunction with running the FB page so huge thanks for filling these positions.

Vote to take place to retain all committee members in current positions, with the exception of Georgina Tooke who is standing down as a committee member. Our thanks once again to Georgina for many years of

hard work, patience (with the children and the committee!) and fabulous scone baking.
